

**EAST CHINA CHARTER TOWNSHIP  
CANAL CLEANING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT PUBLIC HEARING**

**CALL TO ORDER** – Supervisor Simons called the Public Hearing to order at 7:15 p.m., with Clerk Smith, Treasurer Beaudua, and Trustees Patsalis, Blackstock, and Babel. Trustee Horn absent.

**OPEN PUBLIC HEARING FOR COMMENT** – Glen Spencer, 5500 Pointe Drive asked what the benefits of the canal treatments are, and that some residents signed the petition who did not fully understand what they were signing. John Latham, 5526 Pointe Drive said he feels the treatment disturbs the wildlife. A canal resident said that she has plenty of wildlife in and around the canal and hardly any mosquitos with the treatments.

Township Assessor Jaime Barra, said that there are 58% of signatures gathered based on canal frontage, and 61% signers out of the 171 canal residents.
