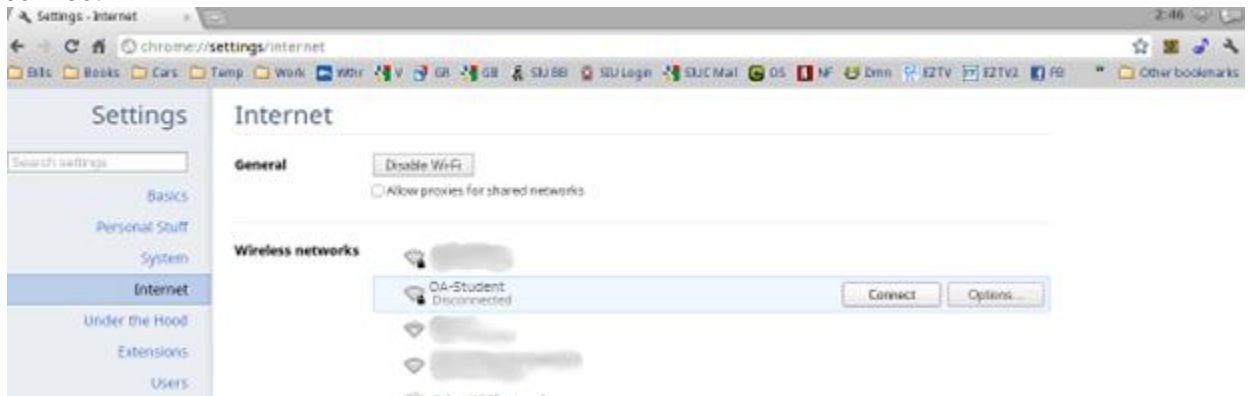


## Connecting to OAHS WiFi – Chromebook Users

1. First, click on the wrench located in the upper right-hand corner, followed by 'Settings'



2. Next, click Internet on the left side and then hover over to 'OA-Student' or 'OA-Staff' and click connect.



3. After that Select 'MSCHAPv2' for 'Phase 2 Authentication', Select 'Do not check' for 'Server CA certificate', enter your computer login under 'Identity' and password, leave the 'Anonymous Identity' field blank and then Click "Connect".
