Garden City Public Schools conducts yearly notifications in accordance with the AHERA regulation. This Annual Notification is made to *"Ensure that workers and building occupants, or their legal guardians, are informed at least once a school year about inspections, response actions, and post-response action activities, including periodic reinspection and surveillance activities that are planned or in progress."* Garden City Public Schools meets this requirement by printing this information in a district newsletter sent out each fall. All newsletters are mailed to school district residents.

**ANNUAL ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION
GARDEN CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

2015 - 2016 SCHOOL YEAR

In accordance with Section 763.84 of the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), or the "Asbestos in Schools Rule," Garden City Public Schools is notifying employees and building occupants, or their legal guardians, of activities conducted within the past school year involving the asbestos inspections, response actions, and post-response action activities, including periodic re-inspection and periodic surveillance activities, that are planned or in progress at School District facilities.

Asbestos surveillances are conducted every six months and continue on a regular schedule. The next round of surveillances will occur in August 2015.

The three year re-inspection activities for all Garden City Public School facilities were conducted in February of 2015. The next three year reinspections will occur in February 2018. All surveillances and re-inspections are conducted by Michigan Licensed Asbestos Inspectors.

Asbestos abatement projects were conducted at The Burger Center, Prior to Demolition during the summer 2015. When necessary to support renovations, abatement is completed in accordance with all state and federal regulations by trained and accredited personnel. Notifications will be provided to potential occupants prior to any scheduled abatement.

The Garden City Public Schools AHERA management plans are available for review at each school, or at the Buildings & Grounds Facility, 1333 Radcliff Garden City, MI 48135. Summaries of abatement projects prior to the 2014-2015 school year are included in the plans, and complete documentation is maintained at the Buildings & Grounds Facility.
