Sharing of academic progress is mandatory.

[Public Act 48 of 2021](#) section 98b requires districts, traditional public, public school academies, and intermediate districts, who wish to receive state aid for 2021-2022 year to:

- **Present, not later than the first board meeting in February 2022 AND no later than the last board meeting of the academic year, on the accomplishments and progress of the established school goals**
- **Post presentation to district transparency site upon completion of presentation to the local board**

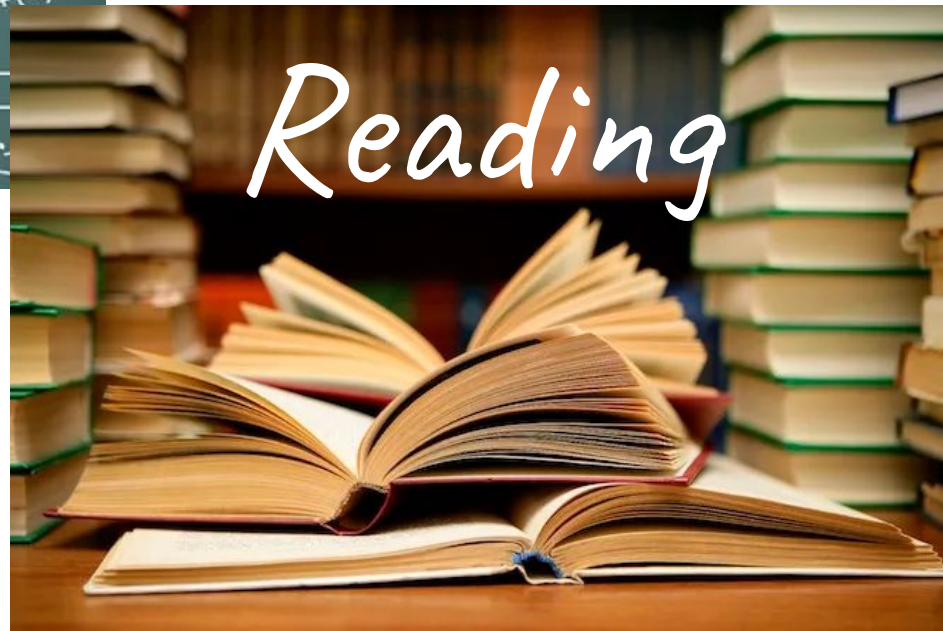
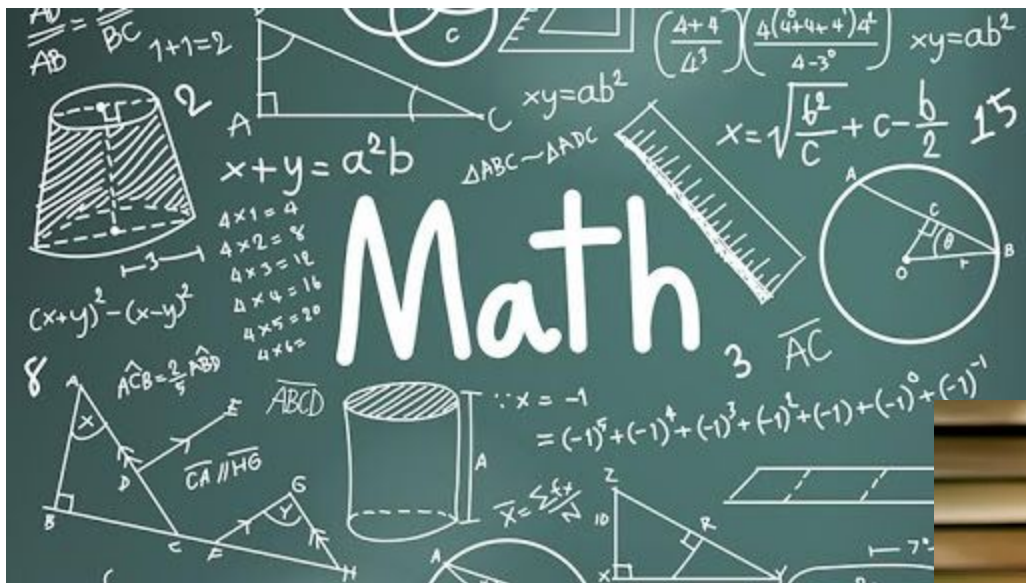
The school goals are required for all buildings/schools – this includes early childhood programs and 9-12 programs. The required benchmarks are for K-8 grade-levels, but the goals in section 98b are for the PK-12 level.



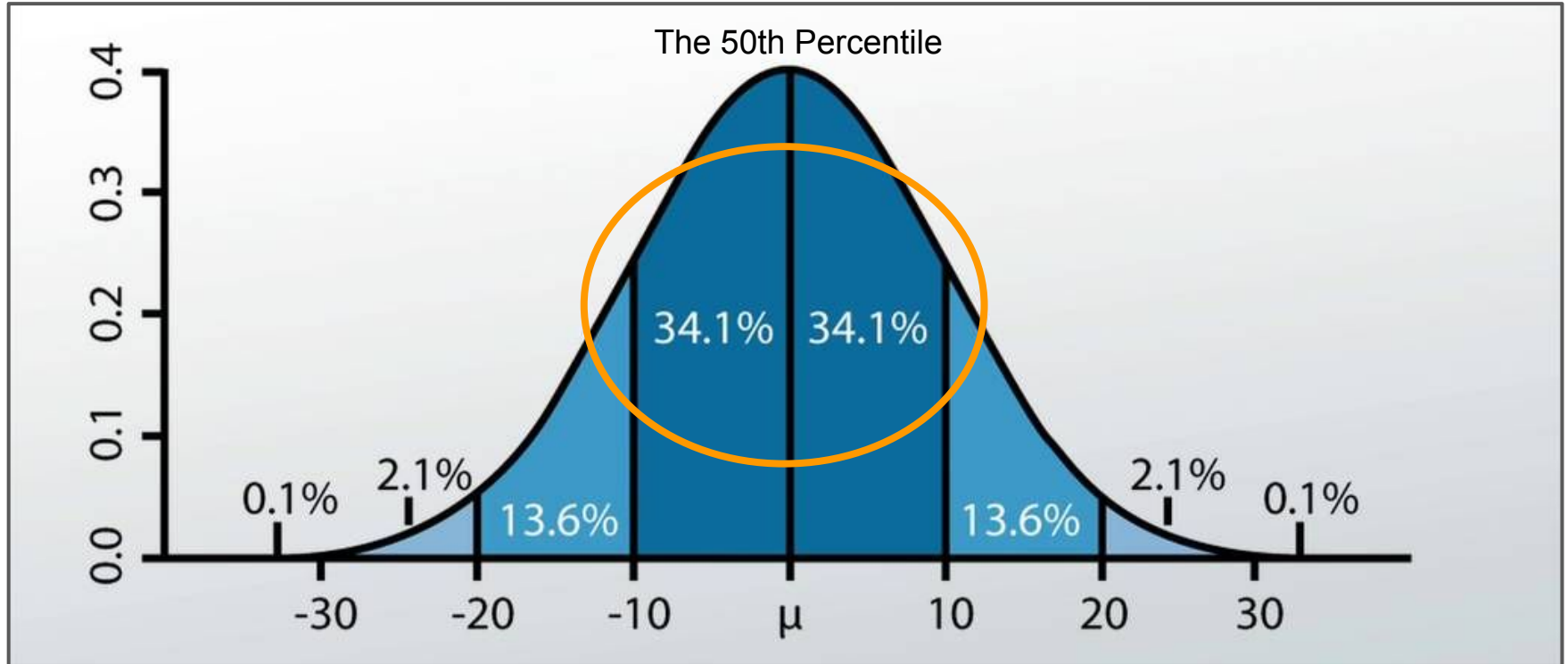
Our goal for all students:

Reading for one year's learning.

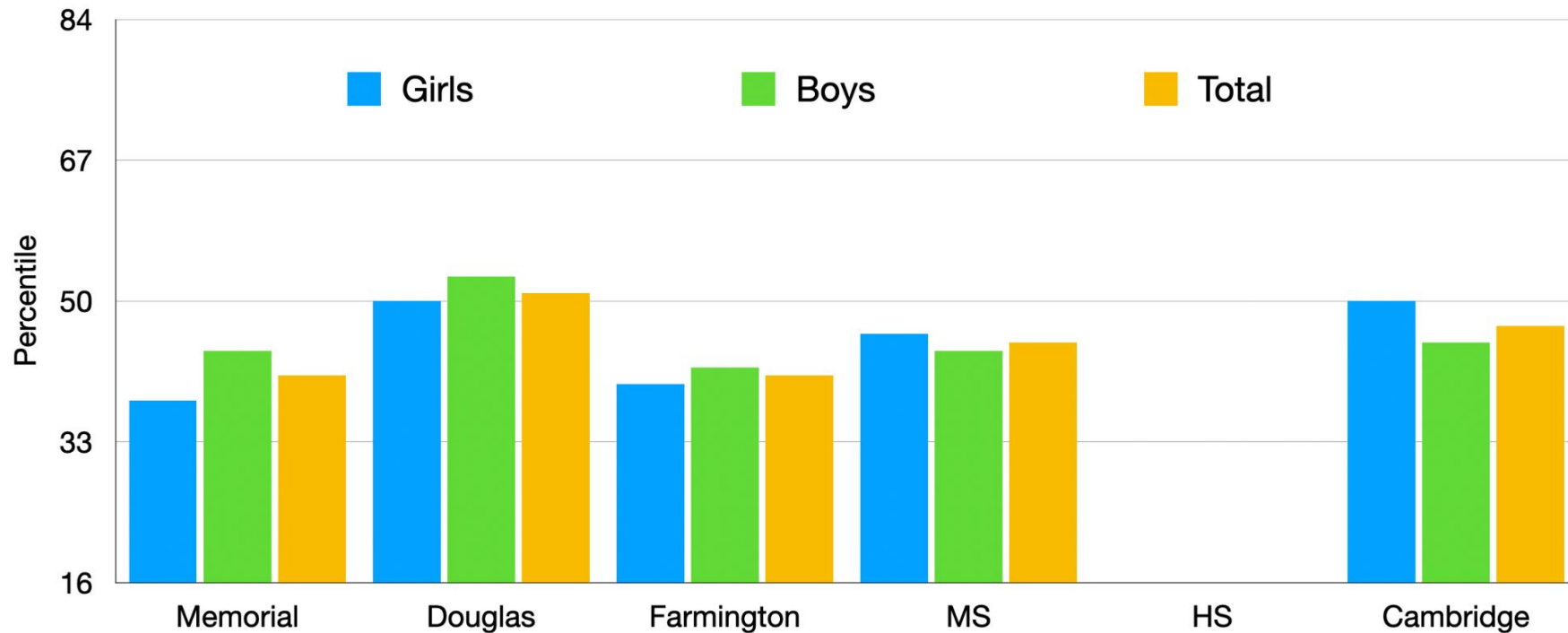




What is normal growth?

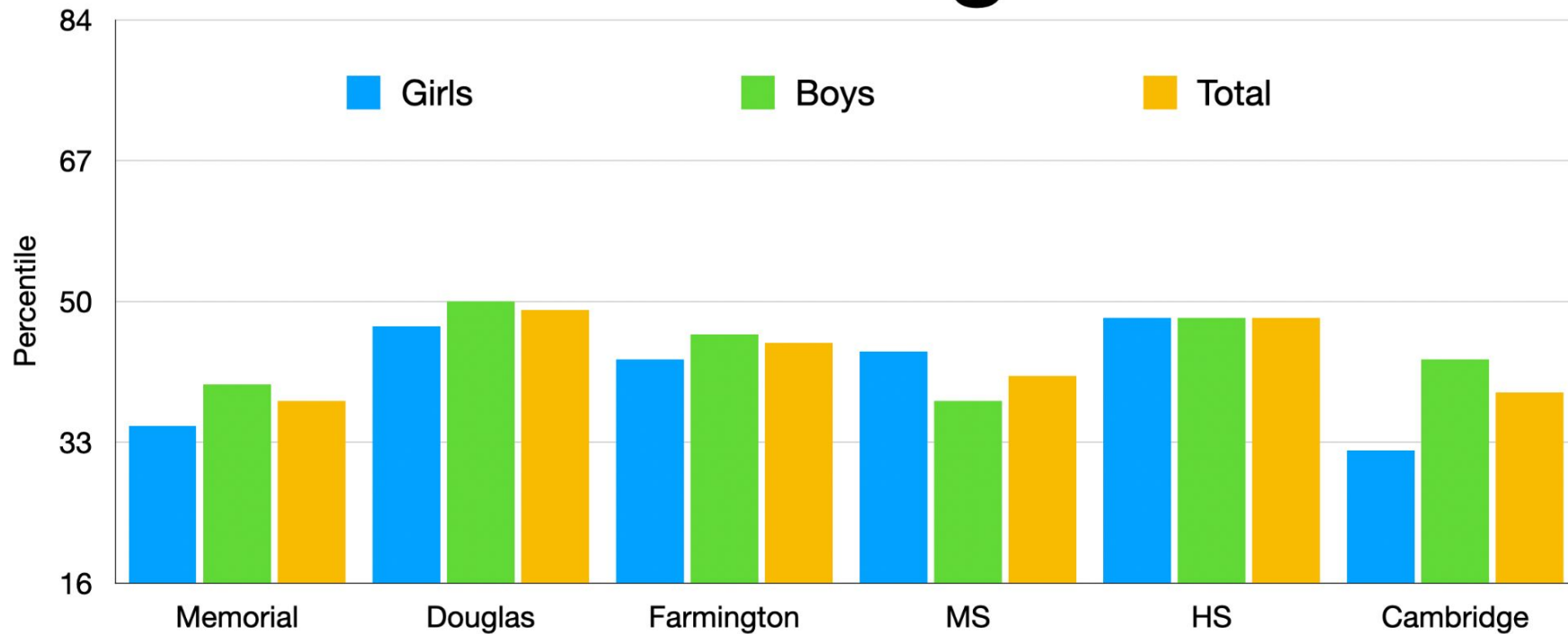


Math

What do the data say?

- Boys, generally, seemed to have better “bounceback” growth than their female counterparts. Female students will need additional interventions through the School Improvement process.
- Younger students seemed to have a more challenging time with growth. For many in our first and second grade, this was their first time in a school. Teachers have reported multiple issues with establishing the “norms” of school.
- Students continue to be impacted by quarantines of themselves, classmates, and teachers. Missed time from school impacted our growth negatively.
- With all we are still dealing with, growth levels were in the normal range for one year’s growth, but more can and needs to be done to help jumpstart student growth.
