1. Reason for Applying

This is not a critical field in the application. Most dual enrollment students will select "Earn transfer credits." Please note that most classes completed through Dual Enrollment at Henry Ford College will apply towards an HFC degree.

Dual Enrollment versus Advancement Plus

Dual Enrollment allows public high school students to take college courses that are paid for by the student's school district or charter school. **Advancement Plus** is a program in which public, private, or home-schooled students may take college courses that are paid for by the student's parent(s)/guardian(s).
