Nonresident Schools of Choice Guidelines

Application Procedure:

All applications will be screened for accurate information. This may involve contacting a former or current school district.

Applications will be accepted online during a specific window of dates between March and August. See application for details. **Applications MAY NOT be received outside of these dates.** [School of Choice Application](#)

All applications must include: application form, behavior report for previous 2 (two) school years and the most recent report card. ALL high school applicants must provide a current transcript. **Discipline affidavit and transcripts are required to complete the application process.**

You will be notified via **email**, regarding the status of your application.

Students may be required to reapply annually for school of choice to remain in Garden City Public Schools.

Athletics:

A secondary student-athlete enrolled through school of choice is not eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics for one full semester as defined and governed by the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA).

Attendance:

Students are expected to arrive and depart from school on time and regularly attend school.

Code of Conduct:

All students enrolled at Garden City Public Schools through school of choice are subject to the Student Code of Conduct. Copies are available at [Student Code of Conduct](#)

Transportation:

Parents of school of choice students are expected to provide transportation to and from school. No transportation is provided for school of choice students.
