

**RESOLUTION 2021-47**

**TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE INHERITANCE TAX FUND (2700)  
TO THE EMERGENCY PHONE 911 FUND (2910)  
AND  
FUNDS TO DEPOSIT DISPATCH SERVICES MONIES IN**

WHEREAS: The Keith County Board of Commissioners have adopted the 2020-2021 Budget of Keith County Nebraska; and

WHEREAS: The revenue for Fund 2910 Code 351 01 Intergovernmental Payments was budgeted at \$15,000.00 for the 2019-2020 budget year; and

WHEREAS: The actual revenue received for Fund 2910 Code 351 01 Intergovernmental Payment was \$0.00 for the 2019-2020 budget year due to the fact the Emergency Manager at some time instructed Treasurer Ronda Johnson to place all Intergovernmental Payments into the General Fund; and

WHEREAS: The revenue for Fund 2910 Code 450 04 911 Surcharges was budgeted at \$30,000.00 for the 2019-2020 budget year; and

WHEREAS: The actual revenue received for Fund 2910 Code 450 04 911 Surcharges was \$8,793.34 for the 2019-2020 budget year due to the fact the Emergency Manager at some time created a new Code 314 01 911 Tax – Company to replace Code 450 04 911 Surcharges; and

WHEREAS: The actual revenue received for the new Code 314 01 911 Tax – Company was \$35,956.65 for the 2019-2020 budget year; and

WHEREAS: The Board nor Communications Director Laurie Hood were aware of these changes; and

WHEREAS: Not knowing of these corrections the Board budgeted revenue for Fund 2910 Code 450 04 911 Surcharges at \$8,000.00 which was a figure partially included in the new Code 314 01; and

WHEREAS: The only revenue going into Fund 2910 is for surcharges; and

WHEREAS: The revenue for these surcharges was budgeted too high; and

WHEREAS: There is not enough revenue going into the Emergency Phone 911 Fund (2910) to pay bills required to be paid out of Emergency Phone 911 Fund (2910).


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT**

1. The Keith County Treasurer transfer \$25,000.00 from the Inheritance Tax Fund (2700) to the Emergency Phone 911 Fund (2910).
2. This transfer is not to be considered a loan and **WILL NOT** be paid back to the Inheritance Tax Fund (2700).
3. In order to sustain the Emergency Phone 911 Fund (2910), beginning on July 1, 2021 all payments received from Arthur County, Grant County, Hooker County, Logan County and McPherson County for dispatch services will go into the Emergency Phone 911 Fund (2910).
4. The payment from the City of Ogallala will continue to go into the General Fund where payroll for dispatch services comes out of.


