The following applications were reviewed and approved:

Reisman 52 Lawrence Avenue	Addition/Alteration- 1 st floor & curved element in Heathcote blend brick, 2 nd floor in stucco sky with textured finish, Grand manor roof shingles in colonial slate, medium bronze roof over cupola, Anderson windows with dark bronze frame, white azek finish at front bays and column covers, gray granite permeable paver driveway w/ 3/8" gravel gap
Eisenberger 45 Merrall Drive	Addition/Alteration Stone to match existing where required for repairs, acrylic stucco to match existing, asphalt roof shingles in Appalachian sky color
Warshawsky 211 Harborview North	New Home 1 st floor and chimney in handmade oversized red brick, 2 nd floor cementitious stucco in color "calm"(beige), all exterior trim work to be versatex wood grain imprint composite trim board in taupe, Vermont blue-gray slate roof, clay flue with grain guard in Sandstone glaze, cedar stained garage door, cast stone entry surround in molded limestone, light beige cast stone window trim & panels, windows with leaded glass option in diamond grill pattern
Briarwood Improvement LLC 100 Briarwood Xing	New Home 1 st and 2 nd floor exterior in white brick, black architectural shingles, driveway in pervious pavers, circular driveway as per plans and approval from Nassau County for second curb cut
Marx 5 Keewaydin Road	Change to design to a more contemporary design Limestone in silver shadow(grey), doors and windows in dark bronze and standing seam metal roof in bronze
