REGULAR MEETING - Mayor Edelman called the regular meeting to order at 8:07 p.m.

PUBLIC HEARING - Public Hearing for Proposed Local Law #2 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours.

Board Action: Trustee Goldstein moved to open the Public Hearing regarding proposed Local Law #2 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours (attached hereto as "Exhibit A"). Deputy Mayor Fragin seconded the motion. All in favor.

Board Action: Upon hearing no further comments or discussion, Mayor Edelman moved to close the Public Hearing regarding proposed Local Law #2 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours. Trustee Goldstein seconded the motion. All in favor.

Trustee Kaufman inquired about making it illegal to park at all times at the corner of Harborview South where it intersects with Harborview East. Village Attorney Peter Bee suggested that the Village use the tool of striping the area in question, which seemed to address Trustee Kaufman's concerns.

Board Action: Trustee Goldstein moved to adopt the proposed Local Law #2 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code prohibiting parking on Harborview South from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., all days; and from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Harborview East, all days, pursuant to a copy of the Local Law #2 of 2017 (attached hereto as "Exhibit A"). Trustee Kaufman seconded the motion. All in favor.

<u>PUBLIC HEARING</u> - Public Hearing for Proposed Local Law #3 of 2017, a Local Law authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c.

Board Action: Mayor Edelman moved to open the Public Hearing regarding proposed Local Law #3 of 2017, a Local Law *only authorizing* a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c (attached hereto as "Exhibit B"). Deputy Mayor Fragin seconded the motion. All in favor.

Board Action: Upon hearing no further comments or discussion, Trustee Kaufman moved to close the Public Hearing regarding proposed Local Law #3 of 2017 a Local Law authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c. Trustee Goldstein seconded the motion. All in favor.

Board Action: Trustee Goldstein moved to adopt the proposed Local Law #3 of 2017 a Local Law authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the limit established in General Municipal Law §3-c (attached hereto as "Exhibit B"). Trustee Kaufman seconded the motion. All in favor.

<u>PUBLIC HEARING</u> - Public Hearing for Proposed Local Law #4 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours (on Lord Avenue West; to be changed from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.).

Board Action: Trustee Diamond moved to open the Public Hearing regarding proposed Local Law #4 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours (attached hereto as "Exhibit C"). Deputy Mayor Fragin seconded the motion. All in favor.

Trustee Diamond stated, for the record, that the reason for this proposed Local Law is because the traffic on Lord Avenue, at these times, has become extremely dangerous for cars, school buses and pedestrians during the morning hours (since Shaaray Tefila added an additional prayer service at 9:30 a.m.).

Board Action: Upon hearing no further comments or discussion, Trustee Goldstein moved to close the Public Hearing regarding proposed Local Law #4 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours. Trustee Diamond seconded the motion. All in favor.

Board Action: Deputy Mayor Fragin moved to adopt the proposed Local Law #4 of 2017 to amend §200-53 Schedule XIV of the Village Code concerning Parking Prohibited Certain Hours; on the West side of Lord Avenue from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.; all days; between Central Avenue and Lismore Road (attached hereto as "Exhibit C"). Trustee Goldstein seconded the motion. All in favor.

Approval of minutes:

BOT January 19, 2017

Deputy Mayor Fragin suggested that the January 19, 2017 BOT meeting minutes be amended to reflect the Work Session start time at 7:00 p.m., as posted and published. A brief discussion ensued in this regard and the above noted change was agreed upon by the Board.

Board Action: Deputy Mayor Fragin moved the approval of the amended January 19, 2017 BOT meeting minutes; to reflect the Work Session start time at 7:00 p.m.. Trustee Diamond seconded the motion. All in favor.

GOOD & WELFARE

- 1. Village resident, Ms. Jacqueline Handel, commended the Village's Department of Public Works for the wonderful snow removal/plowing job done after the blizzardlike snow storm earlier in the day. Mayor Edelman added that he had received many compliments as well, regarding the great job done throughout the Village of plowing the snow and gave credit to Superintendent of the Highway Department, Mr. Robert Daniels.
- Deputy Mayor Fragin stated that Sutton Pond recently overflowed "significantly", during a recent storm with heavy rain and high tides. Deputy Village Administrator Gerry Castro spoke to a resident, who lives adjacent to the Pond, regarding this matter. Mr. Castro added that this is not a check valve issue.
- 3. Deputy Mayor Fragin stated that the Village must enforce restricting the parking on Central Avenue, going in the westbound direction, between the hours of 7 to 9 a.m. (in the morning) and 4 to 7 p.m. (in the afternoon), at the intersection of Rockaway Turnpike, by the long light. Administrator Goldman responded that the new Code Enforcement person was recently trained and was supposed to start tonight (the night of the Board meeting), but due to the snow storm that was not a viable option. Mr. Goldman explained that Mayor Edelman has arranged the new Code Enforcement person's hours to better address (and enforce) this issue going forward. Discussion ensued in this regard.
- 4. Trustee Goldstein raised the issue of illegal parking in front of 301 Central Avenue, by Stefan's Florist. Administrator Goldman and Deputy Administrator Castro stated that there was striping at this location, which would be reviewed as well as more Code Enforcement.
- 5. Trustee Goldstein requested that the Village provide a plaque to be placed on the beautiful clock in front of Stefan's Florist to commemorate Chris Stefan's Page 3 of 19

- generous donation (of said clock) to the Village's Business District landscape. It was noted that the Village did indeed place a bench in Chris Stefan's honor, in front of Stefan's Florist with two such plaques. The matter was noted and taken under advisement.
- 6. Trustee Kaufman stated that although he was aware that Pearsall Avenue is not within the Incorporated Village of Lawrence, "the condition of the road is beyond an embarrassment, it is very dangerous". He inquired as to the status and what can be done to resolve this safety issue. Deputy Administrator Gerry Castro stated that he had spoken with the Village of Cedarhurst as well as the subcontractor working on the electrical upgrades on Pearsall Avenue, who said that as soon as the electrical upgrades are completed, the road would be repaved.
- 7. Mayor Edelman provided an important update regarding the repairs of the street lights on Route 878. He stated that 44 out of the 67 street lights have been repaired by the Village (including underground wiring, wiring, connections at the base of the poles, fuses, bulbs, fixtures sensors, etc.), and the remaining lights are currently being worked on and should be restored to their original "glory" in the near future.
- 8. Mayor Edelman stated that the LY&CC tennis lights were finished.
- Mayor Edelman gave an update regarding the golf course driving range, stating that the poles and netting have been delivered and will be installed/completed shortly.
- 10. Mayor Edelman noted that all Building Department forms and applications can now be obtained and filled out on the Village's website.

Section 2. Authority
This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of said governing body.
Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override
The Board of Trustees of the Village of <u>Lawrence</u> , County of <u>Nassau</u> , is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing <u>June 1, 2017</u> that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law §3-c.
Section 4. Severability
If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm

Section 5. Effective date
