JOB DUTIES

An Operator/Engineer is responsible for routine operation of the fire station. The duties shall include but not be limited to, routine maintenance of fire and ambulance equipment. Must be proficient with SCBA. Must also be proficient on computers to complete EMS charts and Fire reports online. On duty Operator/engineer will be responsible to respond appropriately to emergency calls. The Operator/Engineer can also be on assignment for fire inspections and enforcement.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.
2. High school diploma or GED equivalent.
3. Must possess a valid Nevada Class B driver's license with an F endorsement.
4. Must be State of Nevada EMT and Attendant Certified.
5. Must have Firefighter I or obtain within 6 months, Firefighter II preferred.
6. Position requires working shift work, holidays, weekends, etc.
7. Must possess a positive working relationship with volunteer fire and ambulance personnel and the general public.
