

RESOLUTION OF THE MINERAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
RESOLUTION NO. 21-001

**RENEWABLE ENERGY GENERATION PROJECT PERMIT FEE**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MINERAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MINERAL COUNTY, NEVADA:

WHEREAS, the Board of Mineral County Commissioners is responsible for the regulation of all matters relating to the construction, maintenance and safety of buildings, structures, and property within the County as set forth in Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) 244.3675 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mineral County Code 17.52.020 *et seq.* an application processing fee, as established by the Mineral County Board of Commissioners, shall be collected for any application for a renewable energy generation project permit.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following application fee is enacted for renewable energy generation permit applications:

Any new or amended renewable energy facility proposing construction, development, and/or change of use/expansion within Mineral County, shall deposit with the County twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) at the time the renewable energy generation project permit application is filed with the County. Said deposit shall be used for services provided by county departments, specialized or skilled professionals retained by the County to review and determine the possible impacts of the proposed use or conditions to be placed upon granting the permit and/OR to assist with analysis of data, oversight of the monitoring plan, etc. No permit shall be issued until the deposit is lodged with the County.

If the special use permit application is denied, the outstanding balance of the deposit shall be returned to applicant after the time for filing appeals and petitions for judicial review have expired. If the special use permit is granted, the deposit shall be retained and utilized by the County for the services used by the County to monitor compliance with the conditions of the special use permit. At the time the special use permit is granted, applicant, as a condition of the special use permit, may be required to deposit additional funds with the County to bring the balance of the deposit back up to twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00).
