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RESOLUTION No. 21-002 OF THE MINERAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, a Petition was filed with the Mineral County Board of Commissioners pertaining to the vacation and abandonment of the alley herein fully described,

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed vacation and abandonment of the alley, hereinafter described, was duly posted in the manner and form required by law, noticing a public hearing on said Petition, not less than 10 business days before the public hearing,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the 3rd of February 2021, and the 17th of February 2021, being the time and place set forth in said Notice of hearing on the Petition set forth above, and

WHEREAS, the Mineral County Board of Commissioners are now satisfied that the public will not be materially injured by such proposed abandonment,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mineral County Board of Commissioners, that the alley hereinafter described is vacated, to-wit:


All the alley running a northerly and southerly direction through Block 35, between "E" and "F" Streets, for a distance of five hundred feet (500') more or less, in the Town of Hawthorne, County of Mineral, State of Nevada, as delineated on the office Plat of said Town of Hawthorne, on file in the office of the Recorder of Mineral County, Hawthorne, Nevada.

Except that Mineral County and the Town of Hawthorne retain an easement for all utilities located within said alleyway, including but not limited to gas, water, sewer, power, and trash service.
