

RESOLUTION NO. 22-026

WHEREAS, Mineral County has proclaimed the week of May 14 - 21, 2023 for the 72nd Annual Armed Forces Celebration;

WHEREAS, Mineral County recognizes Armed Forces as the largest celebration of the year and the significant importance to the local economy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mineral County Board of Commissioners grant the Mineral County Sheriff and Mineral County Fire Chief the authority to temporarily close county roads and reduce speed limits in support of this celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Hawthorne Utilities shall provide dumpsters and trash receptacles for trash removal in support of this celebration;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mineral County Board of Commissioners waive Mineral County business license fees for Armed Forces Day vendors in support of this celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mineral County Public Works shall provide services for street clean up before and after the celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ordinances relating to noise level restrictions are hereby not to restrict Armed Forces Celebration noise levels arising during this celebration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that camping be and hereby is permitted at Lions Park and allow Veterans Park and Patriots Park to be and hereby designated for use as vendor areas during the celebration;
