

RESOLUTION NO. 19-006

WHEREAS Mineral County has proclaimed May, 2019, Armed Forces Month, and the week of May 13 through 20, 2019, Armed Forces Week;

WHEREAS Mineral County's recognizes Armed Forces Week as the largest celebration of the year and the of significant importance to the local economy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mineral County Board of Commissioners grant the Mineral County Sheriff and Mineral County Fire Chief the authority to temporarily close county roads and reduce speed limits in support of this celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Hawthorne Utilities shall provide dumpsters and trash receptacles for trash removal in support of this celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mineral County Board of Commissioners waive Mineral County business license fees for Armed Forces Day vendors in support of this celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mineral County Public Works shall provide services for street clean up before and after this celebration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that ordinances relating to noise level restrictions are hereby not to restrict Armed Forces Week noise levels arising during this celebration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that camping be and hereby is permitted at Lions Park and allow Veterans Park be and hereby is designated for use as vendor areas during the celebration.


