

RESOLUTION OF THE MINERAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
RESOLUTION NO. 20-015

CREATION OF OFFICE OF MINERAL COUNTY COMPTROLLER

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MINERAL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HAWTHORNE,
NEVADA:

WHEREAS, the Board of Mineral County Commissioners is responsible for the management and accounting of public funds as set forth in Nevada Revised Statutes (“NRS”) 244.200 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Mineral County Recorder, per NRS chapter 251, is the ex-officio county auditor unless a comptroller is appointed by the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 251.170 in Counties having a population of 100,000 or less and no county manager, the Board of County Commissioners may appoint a county comptroller;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the position of Mineral County Comptroller is hereby created and that such position may be hired by and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Mineral County Commissioners unless the position of a county manager is created within the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the comptroller shall be the chief fiscal officer of the county and shall perform all duties required of county auditors and comptrollers as set forth in NRS chapter 251 and any other applicable law or ordinance, and the comptroller shall oversee the centralized billing and collections systems of the county, under the general oversight of the Board of County Commissioners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this alteration of the County’s chief fiscal officer shall not take effect until such time as the position is funded and hired by the Board of County Commissioners.
