MINERAL COUNTY DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

RESOLUTION OF THE MINERAL COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
DECLARING A COUNTY WIDE STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE COUNTY OF
MINERAL DUE TO THE IMPACT OF RECENT ATMOSPHERIC RIVERS AND
ADVERSE WEATHER.

WHEREAS, Mineral County is a political subdivision of the State of Nevada and is authorized under the powers granted under Chapter 414 of the Nevada Revised Statutes to declare an emergency; and

WHEREAS, the impact of recent atmospheric rivers and adverse winter weather has caused substomatal property damages poses a serious threat to health and safety as well as property of the residents of Mineral County, Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the weather event, having occurred between March 8, 2023, and March 23, 2023, affected the entirety of Mineral County, including the communities of Hawthorne, Walker Lake, Mina, and Luning; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners finds that emergency conditions prevail and threats to health, life, safety and welfare of persons and property due to severe flooding has occurred and is occurring within Mineral County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Mineral County does hereby resolve that, under the provisions of the Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 414, a State of Emergency does exist due to conditions of peril arising from the severe weather conditions within Mineral County.

BE IT SO ORDERED this 29th day of March 2023.
