JOB DUTIES

The Utility Operator 1/Mechanic performs duties involved in repair and maintenance of fleet vehicle and heavy equipment, fabrication using welding equipment, construction, operation, maintenance and repair of Water Systems in Hawthorne, Mina and Luning; Hawthorne Wastewater system and assist other Utility Operations as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must be 18 years of age.
2. Must have a high school diploma or GED equivalent
3. Must have experience with vehicle and heavy equipment maintenance and repair
4. A preference will be given to applicants holding a Nevada Grade 1 Certification in Water Distribution (D-1). If no applicant holds the certification, the successful applicant must obtain a D-1 Certification within two (2) testing periods.
5. A full Class B with Air Brakes and Tanker Endorsement, and Standard Shift Endorsement Commercial Drivers License (CDL) at the time of application. If no applicant fulfills this requirement, successful applicant must obtain within 6 months of hire date, a Nevada CDL-Class B with above endorsements.
6. Must be able to work outside on a regular basis with exposure to dust, fumes of levels within regulatory standards and limits. Will have occasional adverse weather or otherwise undesirable conditions.
7. Must be able to meet physical demands include lifting, walking, bending, stooping, climbing, crawling, squatting and periods of standing.
