

NORTHAMPTON COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS
RESOLUTION TO RELOCATE SEVERN PRECINCT

WHEREAS, the Northampton County Board of Elections has the authority and statutory duty to establish, alter, discontinue or create such new election precincts or voting places as it may deem expedient in accordance with North Carolina General Statute 163-128; and

WHEREAS, the Northampton County Board of Elections has complied with the applicable statutory requirements by ensuring said polling site meets all federal Help America Vote Act (HAVA) requirements; and


WHEREAS, the Northampton County Board of Elections shall give forty-five (45) days notice therefore prior to the next primary or election, and the county board of elections shall mail a notice no later than thirty (30) days prior to each registered voter who as a result of the change will be assigned to a different polling place, and appropriate notices shall be given to the county political chairs and posted at the courthouse door and at the board of elections' office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Northampton County Board of Elections hereby approves the relocation of the following precinct with the approved polling location;
