

19.0 – OUTDOOR SECURITY LIGHTING

Dusk-to-dawn outdoor security lighting is available to all customers who take electric service from the Utility under one of the Standard Rate Schedules. The location must be within the Utility's designated service territory. Only single phase, 60 hertz, 120 volt service is available.

Lighting units will only be of the high pressure sodium (HPS) type of NEMA head, mast mounted configuration. Sizes available are 100, 150, 250, and 400 watts. Rates vary with the size of the unit per the Standard Rate Schedule for this service.

Installation of security lights must be on an existing Utility pole where secondary voltage lines already exist or on a customer-owned pole approved by the Utility. The Utility will furnish the first 100 feet of overhead duplex wire for installation where existing lines are overhead. All underground wire will be paid for and owned by the customer.

Lighting units will be furnished, installed and maintained by the Utility including the normal replacement of lamps, ballasts, photoelectric controls, etc. Normal replacement does not include frequent replacement due to recurring vandalism or malicious mischief. Electric energy is furnished by the Utility but only on a dusk-to-dawn basis. Manual on-off switching for security lights is not available.

Upon request, the Utility will install a pole at a location mutually agreeable to the Utility and customer with costs based on present pole and wire costs to be paid by the customer.

Lights intended for mounting on customer-owned building structures are not available under this service.

Monthly rates for lighting under this service may be obtained from the Utilities office.
