PLUMBING RESIDENTIAL APPLICATION

Permits are good for six (6) MONTHS from date of issue providing you have had an inspection once in a six (6) month period.

Vacuum breakers required on all outside faucets and any hose bib or laundry tray inside building that will take a hose.

Firestopping required where pipe goes through any plate.

One (1) fixture per branch on sanitary.

Water pipe must be three-quarter inch (3/4") main, half inch (1/2") to fixture and only one (1) fixture on half inch (1/2") line.

Nail plates required 2" down from top plate and 2" above bottom plate.

Stud shoes (or equivalent) required on all non-bearing studs drilled larger than 60% and bearing walls cannot exceed 40%.

DO NOT USE TEE'S ON HORIZONTAL LINES, EXCEPT DRY VENTS.

Underground inspection for residential is an additional inspection if not incorporated with the Rough inspection.

Temporary occupancy requires one (1) complete bathroom, kitchen sink, laundry facility, and hot and cold running water. Inspection required for temporary occupancy.

All fixtures must be installed or lines capped for Final inspection.

ABS (black pipe) CANNOT be glued to PVC (white pipe). Proper adapter must be used.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS IS STRICTLY A GUIDE. IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT THE SPECIFIC INSPECTOR BE CONTACTED TO ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS.
