

Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician-Advanced Brighton Fire Department

General

Employee must always promote a professional image of BFD. Consistently demonstrate positive, effective communication skills with the BFD, Fire Chief, other employees and volunteers, other public and private individuals and agencies, all mutual aid departments, and the community. Work in a safe manner, maintain a professional appearance, and positively represent BFD at all times. Demonstrate a comprehensive knowledge of BFD's rules, and consistently and appropriately enforce BFD's rules. Perform other duties and/or tasks as may be assigned by the Fire Chief or Officer.

Firefighter/EMT Duties and Responsibilities are not limited to the following:

- Respond to calls for service from dispatch and be ready to assist any walk-ins.
- Attend training courses; read and study assigned materials; related to AEMT level for emergency medical services and firefighting skills.
- Keep up State required training to maintain Medical License along with current BLS card.
- Complete any assignments that are assigned by the Fire Chief or Officer.
- Knowledgeable in the procedures and operations under the ICS.
- Familiar with standard concepts, practices, and procedures within field.
- Self - motivated, and must be able to multi-task
- Maintaining station cleanliness and performing all daily station duties
- Stocking all apparatuses and medical response bags to abide by state requirements

Mandatory Qualifications and Requirements

- Not have been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor involving "moral turpitude" as the term is defined by law and not have been released or discharged under any other than honorable conditions from any of the armed forces of United States.
- Minimum age 21
- Current valid Driver's License with F endorsement
- High school diploma or GED
- Function in varied environmental conditions such as light or darkened work areas, extreme heat, cold as well as all extreme weather, confined spaces, and smoke-filled environments.

Desired Qualifications

- Completed Fire 2 State Commissioned
- State level AEMT or above
- Knowledge of all AEMT skills and protocols
- Is well informed on current Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

-- While performing the duties of this job, the employee must physically be able to climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, lift, drag, and carry.

-- The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to over 100 pounds.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

The work environment characteristics described here are a generic representation of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job.

-- While performing the duties of this job, the employee frequently works in/near hazardous situations, as well as in all outside weather conditions. The employee is regularly exposed to wet and/or humid conditions, fumes, toxic or caustic chemicals. MVCs, train derailments, vehicle fires, and commercial structure fires, as well as any given structure fire may contain HAZMAT material and may require extra precautions.

-- Fire Fighter will be trained on all Brighton Fire Department apparatuses, rescue equipment, and tools; as well as ESO software for all fire and incident reports.

-- A drug and background screening will be performed.
