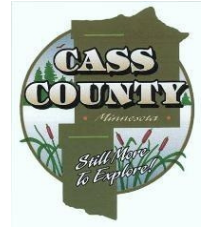

Dear Applicant:

Effective May 26, 2005, a significant change in laws regarding handguns was adopted by the Minnesota Legislature. Permits to carry issued pursuant to the new law will be valid for 5 years. Applicants are responsible for receiving approved training before a permit to carry will be issued. Evidence of successful completion of this training within 1 year of application must be submitted with the permit application. This department can assist you in identifying locations where approved training can be obtained.

Attached please find the new Minnesota Uniform Firearm Application Permit to Carry a Pistol.

In order for the Cass County Sheriff's Office to process your **NEW** application, you must:

- ✓ Read the application carefully and answer every question.
- ✓ Sign application in all 3 places.
- ✓ Submit required documentation, certificates and photocopies, as noted in application.
- ✓ Submit a \$100.00 fee with the application. This fee is non-refundable. Make check payable to "Cass Co Sheriff's Office"
- ✓ Turn in the application in person to our department and receive a receipt from the officer accepting your application.

In order for the Cass County Sheriff's Office to process your **RENEWAL** application, you must:

- ✓ Make sure you are renewing less than 90 days before your permit expires or 30 days after. If your permit has been expired for 31 days or more, it is considered a new gun permit application and will be subject to the \$100 fee. An expired permit is not active while in the renewal process.
- ✓ Read the application carefully and answer every question.
- ✓ Sign application in all 3 places.
- ✓ Submit required documentation, certificates and photocopies, as noted in application, **along with a copy of your current gun permit.**
- ✓ Submit a \$75.00 fee with the application. This fee is non-refundable. Make check payable to "Cass Co Sheriff's Office"
- ✓ Turn in the application in person to our office and receive a receipt from the officer accepting your application.
