Eligibility	Pediatric (0 through 18 years)	Adult (19 years and up)
MHCP-enrolled	Yes, all ACIP-recommended childhood vaccines	Not eligible
Uninsured	Yes, all ACIP-recommended childhood vaccines	Yes, certain adult vaccines are available in clinics that MDH has accepted into the UUAV program
Underinsured ¹	Only at LPH, FQHC, RHC, tribal health, and IHS clinics for all ACIP-recommended childhood vaccines	
American Indian or Alaskan Native	Yes, all ACIP-recommended childhood vaccines	May be eligible for certain adult vaccines if they are un- or underinsured at a UUAV clinic

¹ Only at local public health (LPH), Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC), Rural Health Centers (RHC), tribal health, and Indian Health Services (IHS) clinics.

² Underinsured is defined as patients with private insurance that does not cover the vaccine itself or has a cap.
