



CASS SWCD Monitoring Plan for annual Buffer Compliance Reviews

103F.48 RIPARIAN PROTECTION AND WATER QUALITY PRACTICES.

1. COMPLIANCE TRACKING OF ALL PARCELS SUBJECT TO THE BUFFER LAW

All parcels in the county are reviewed within a 3-year timeframe.

2. RANDOM SPOT CHECKS

Random spot checks will be done in addition to tracking of all parcels within a 3 – year span. These checks will be done via aerial photo review or on-site review, or a combination of both. An example could be a parcel that was previously non-compliant or a parcel that utilized buffer funds to come into compliance.

3. PROCESS TO HANDLE COMPLAINTS

- Upon noticed complaint, SWCD will verify if parcel is on DNR buffer map and reference existing documentation.
- Compliance determination will be evaluated via aerial photo and/or site visit with landowner.
- If parcel is found out of compliance, SWCD will work with landowner to become compliant.
- SWCD may provide landowner technical and/or financial assistance.
- If landowner does not come into compliance by a given timeline, a Notification of Noncompliance will be sent to BWSR.
- Upon completion, the SWCD may issue a validation of Compliance if requested by landowner.
