**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE STANNARD TOWNSHIP PARK CAMPGROUND
CAMPERS/VISITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR READING AND UNDERSTANDING THE RULES FOR
STANNARD TOWNSHIP PARK CAMPGROUND. CAMPGROUND RULES ARE POSTED ON THE BULLETIN
BOARD BY THE DUMP STATION. Rules are also available on the Stannard Township Website:

1. There will be no camping before payment. Payment in full and registration is required prior to total set up.
2. There will be no littering within the camper park grounds. All waste must be placed in the containers provided by Stannard Township.
3. All picnic tables, and fire rings must be clean before leaving the site. Taking picnic tables from another site is prohibited. Fires are strictly prohibited outside of any designated fire ring.
4. The damaging or destruction of any Township property is prohibited and any violation of this rule or regulation shall be subject to prosecution. Persons shall not destroy, damage or remove Township property, trees, shrubs, wild flowers or other vegetation and may not cut trees in the park boundaries.
5. All pets shall be in full control of the owner. Any loud, constant barking or howling of dogs will not be tolerated. The owner will be liable for any damage or injuries caused by their pet. Pets are restricted to the lot area of the owner, unless the owner takes the animal off the lot on a restraint. The owner of any pet must insure that droppings are cleaned up immediately and disposed of properly.
6. The use of full size appliances, such as washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, freezers not permanently affixed to the camper is strictly prohibited.
7. The illegal use of alcoholic beverages or intoxicants is strictly prohibited, as well as the possession and/or use of any drugs prohibited by law. Users of the Township Park shall conduct themselves in a manner that respects the rights of other camper park users to enjoy the Township Park as a recreational facility for people of all ages.
8. The speed limit on all roads within the park shall be 5 miles per hour.
9. Quiet hours must be observed between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Non-registered visitor hours are 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
10. The campsite should be kept in neat appearance.
11. Camping will be permitted only in established campground sites or in areas designated by the Township Board.
12. No parking in vacant sites. Violators will be towed at the owner's expense.
13. No more than one camp, occupied by a single family, will be permitted on an individual lot. No camp shall occupy more than one site unless additional sites fees are paid.
14. Children must be under the supervision of a parent or responsible adult.
15. Persons shall not discharge or operate firearms, air guns (BB, pellet, etc.), sling-shots or bow and arrow within the park boundaries. There shall be no hunting, trapping, killing or intentionally disturbing wild life within the park boundaries.
16. Check out time shall be 11:00 a.m.
17. No livestock of any type is permitted in the park.
