Dear Mr. Swett,

On December 15, 2021 notice was sent to DEP regarding Ecos Energy's withdrawal of the Application for a Water Quality Certification. In that email notification, which the Town of Ware was copied, Ecos explained that it was our intent to revise the project to eliminate the permanent wetland crossing.

As a result of the redesign, a temporary wetland crossing is shown where the previously proposed permanent crossing was located, thus reducing the amount of disturbance within the wetland resource area. This temporary crossing is crucial to the final connection to the National Grid system. This revision is reflected on the plans sent by email correspondence to the Town on January 12,2022 and the same set delivered to the Conservation Commission at the January 12, 2022, meeting.

Over the last several years this project has been through numerous revisions. Most revisions to this project have been to the benefit of the Town and the surrounding abutters. The initial 2018 scope of the project had many more impacts to the wetland resource areas and their buffer zones. The project currently before the Commission shows a much-reduced scope with no permanent disturbance to the wetland resources.

A revised Notice of Intent form is included with this letter. Please accept the revised plans as supporting documents for the ongoing review of the proposed project.
