

Re: Wetlands Delineation for work in

the Buffer Zone, 13 Wildflower Dr. Ware

I delineated the wetland resource areas at the above-referenced property after several days of rain (over 4 inches). It is my understanding that this is in preparation for extending the lawn area to reduce the existing steep side slopes and make mowing easier. I began upgradient of the driveway crossing with pink flag W1 at the property line.

I based my delineation primarily on the vegetation present, keeping the raspberry, multiflora rose, asian bittersweet and tatarian honeysuckle on the upland side of the line. The brook flows through the front yard, parallel to the street before turning and flowing along the swale on the southern property line towards Gould Rd.

It appears that catch basins in Wildflower Drive are directing stormwater runoff into this swale, increasing the volume and intensity of stormwater flows. There is a larger gap between flag W12 and W13 due to the dense growth of rose and black raspberry bushes in the upland next to the swale (photo below). Additionally the topographic break in slope is generally consistent with the wetland boundary. I ended with flag W15 where the stream leaves the property.



<u>Vegetation observed within the wetland includes</u>: jewelweed, northern arrowwood, red maple, skunk cabbage, american elm, sensitive fern, an unknown sedge and glossy buckthorn.

<u>Vegetation observed within the upland includes</u>: pokeweed, asian bittersweet, lady's thumb smartweed, japanese barberry, garlic mustard, oxeye daisy, mullein, black cherry, dandelion, wild lettuce, forsythia, hayscented fern, wood sorrel, virginia creeper, euonymus, and staghom sumac.

I would recommend that the fair number of invasive species present in the buffer zone be removed as part of the plan to extend the lawn and that native upland and wetland shrub and wildflower species be planted to replace them.

The attached copy of the NRCS soil mapping indicates that the site has only upland units of Hinckley loamy sand and Scituate fine sandy loam soils. Ridgebury hydric soils are often found as a minor component of Scituate soil, which appears to be the case in this location.


I researched MassGIS data layers further and determined that there are no rare species, priority habitats, certified or potential vernal pools on the site or within 100-feet. The wetland is not considered to be an Outstanding Resource Water or an Area of Critical Environmental Concern. There is no 100-year floodplain depicted on the site according to the MassGIS FEMA data layer map attached.


