

C. Project Description.

 Project Location: 26 Beach Rd, Ware, Ma. Assessors Map/Plot Number 55 Parcel/Lot Number 48-0-55

b. Area Description.

In front of the house are three pine trees, all within 100 feet of the lake. The three pine trees are at least 80 feet tall. They pose a threat to the house. Enclosed photos identify these three trees, as well as two other photos that show a history of this threat.

2. Work Description.

Robinson Tree Service, upon your approval, will use a crane to cut and remove the trees from the property. This service has recently, successfully, removed a number of infested white oak trees from neighboring properties.

Attached are photos that identify the three trees.

Also attached, are photos that document recent tree damage. One photo documents the early snowfall in November, 2011. Our house sustained damage to a roof and the interior ceiling. The other photo shows a tree that fell in August of 2020. If it had fallen 15 degrees to the west, it would have destroyed the house.
