B. Determination

Pursuant to the authority of M.G.L. c. 131, § 40, the Conservation Commission considered your Request for Determination of Applicability, with its supporting documentation, and made the following Determination.

Project Description (if applicable):

Project Exempt per 310 CMR 10.01(2)(a)2. - Project entails: removing existing lead-based paint from the structure (the stop log structure) and restore surfaces with an environmental friendly and durabe paint product. Care will be taken to ensure that no material will enter the waters. Prior to commencement of any work, a staging platform and enclosure will be constructed. The containment will consists of a work platform with a EDPM rubber coated containment basin, walls and a roof. No installation shall occur underwater. Equipment and materials will be staged from an adjacent roadside parking area above the stop log area. Lead-based paint will be removed using Greener Blast System and be collected in the containment basin, pumped to containers at roadway staging area and properly disposed. Following removal, a 3-coat macropoxy system by Sherwin Wiliams will be applied to the metal components.

The applicant, owner, any person aggrieved by this Determination, any owner of land abutting the land upon which the proposed work is to be done, or any ten residents of the city or town in which such land is located, are hereby notified of their right to request the appropriate Department of Environmental Protection Regional Office (see https://www.mass.gov/service-details/massdep-regional-offices-bycommunity) to issue a Superseding Determination of Applicability. The request must be made by certified mail or hand delivery to the Department, with the appropriate filing fee and Fee Transmittal Form (see Request for Departmental Action Fee Transmittal Form) as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten business days from the date of issuance of this Determination. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent by certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and to the applicant if he/she is not the appellant. The request shall state clearly and concisely the objections to the Determination which is being appealed. To the extent that the Determination is based on a municipal ordinance or bylaw and not on the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act or regulations, the Department of Environmental Protection has no appellate jurisdiction.
