

City of Albion Park Rules version 2022-07-12

1. Parks are open from dawn to dusk. Vehicle parking within the parks is not permitted after dusk.
2. Children under 6 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
3. No person shall injure, mar or damage in any manner any monument, ornament, fence, bridge, seat, tree, fountain, shrub, flower, playground equipment, fireplace or other public property within or pertaining to the public parks or playgrounds.
4. No person shall litter in the parks, on the park grounds or trails, or in any river located within or flowing through park grounds or trails.
5. No alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, marihuana, or other intoxicants are allowed within the parks.
6. The discharge of fireworks within the parks is strictly prohibited.
7. No sound amplification is allowed within the parks without City Council approval.
8. Dogs and other animals must be on a leash at all times while in the parks. Animal waste must be removed by the owner(s) of the animal or person(s) accompanying the animal in the parks.
9. No person shall urinate or defecate in any park regardless of whether the location is in public view, except in permanent restrooms or portable toilets open to the public.
10. The discharge of firearms within the parks is prohibited.
11. Hunting within the parks is prohibited.
12. Motor vehicles are not permitted on grass, footpaths, sidewalks, or trails within the parks with the exception of motorized wheelchairs, e-bikes, City maintenance vehicles, and City Public Safety vehicles. Motor vehicles are permitted on the grass within the parks strictly for purposes of loading and/or unloading the motor vehicle, but any motor vehicle located on the grass for purposes of loading and/or unloading the motor vehicle shall be immediately removed from the grass once loading and/or unloading is complete.
13. No open fires are permitted within the parks except in barbeque grills.
14. Reservation(s) of park shelters and pavilions must be made at City Hall.
15. Overnight camping within the parks is not permitted.

16. No tents or canopies larger than 10' x 10' are allowed within the parks or permitted to be erected within the parks without the approval of City Council.

17. FINES: USE THE EXISTING CODE BELOW.

Sec. 1-25. General penalty.

- (a) Unless another penalty is expressly provided by this Code for any particular provision or section, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Code or any rule, regulation or order adopted or issued in pursuance thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and costs of prosecution or by imprisonment for not more than 93 days or by both such fine, costs and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. Each act of violation and every day upon which any such violation shall occur shall constitute a separate offense.
- (b) The penalty provided by this section, unless another penalty is expressly provided, shall apply to the amendment of any section of this Code, whether or not such penalty is reenacted in the amendatory ordinance.
- (c) The penalty shall be in addition to the abatement of the violating condition, any injunctive relief or revocation of any permit or license.
