

**CITY OF ALBION
ORDINANCE #2021-06**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 22, ARTICLE VI, TO AMEND
SECTION 22-222 AUTHORIZED MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS**

Purpose and Finding:

The City currently has an ordinance authorizing applications and licenses for adult use (recreational) marijuana facilities within the City of Albion. The authorization is specifically limited to growers and processors. The City Council recently expressed an interest in limiting the number of licenses available for adult use facilities. This ordinance modifies the number of licenses from 20 to 5. Approval is recommended.

THE CITY OF ALBION ORDAINS:

Section 1. Chapter 22, Article VI, Section 22-222, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Albion, is hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE VI: ADULT USE MARIHUANA FACILITIES

Sec. 22-222. Authorized Marijuana Establishments

The city hereby authorizes, subject to the issuance of a municipal license by the City, the following types of marijuana establishments within the boundaries of the city, pursuant to section 6.1 of Act:

- a. Class A Marijuana Grower
- b. Class B Marijuana Grower
- c. Class C Marijuana Grower
- d. Marijuana Processor

Subject to any other condition contained in this article, the City Clerk, after approval from the City Council, may issue up to an aggregate total of five (5) marijuana establishment licenses for the establishments listed in this Section.

The City Council declares this ordinance to be an emergency ordinance.


Section 2. Severability. This ordinance and each article, section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, part, provision, sentence, word and portion thereof are hereby declared to be severable, and if they or any of them are declared to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected.

This Ordinance shall take immediate effect after publication.


