Hello, and welcome to the City of Anna Maria!

Please read the following information carefully – more information is available in our City Code at: www.cityofannamaria.com . You may also stop in at City Hall for more information.

ALL PARKING LAWS ARE STRICTLY ENFORCED IN THE CITY OF ANNA MARIA

*All tires must be off pavement where permitted parking allowed. *Follow all parking/directional signs.
*Do not block any driveways. *Per Florida Statutes: Park with the flow of traffic, do not park with any part of the vehicle on the sidewalk, do not park within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, do not park within 20 feet of a crosswalk, do not park within 30 feet of a stop sign, and do not angular park unless posted otherwise.

SEA TURTLES

The following activities and situations are prohibited on the beach from sunset to sunrise during Sea Turtle nesting season May 1 – October 31:

- Floodlights, up lights or spotlights that are directly visible from the beach, or which indirectly or directly or cumulatively illuminate the beach, are prohibited.
- Artificial lighting must not directly or indirectly illuminate the beach during nesting season.
- Operation of all motorized vehicles is prohibited at any time with the exception of law enforcement/emergency vehicles.
- Building of campfires/bonfires is prohibited.
- Temporary lighting that purposely illuminates nesting/hatchling sea turtles is prohibited.
- Temporary structures (cabanas, chairs, man-made items) must be removed from the beach from sunset to sunrise.

To help minimize beachside lighting, please shield all lights and close all drapes after dark. To report a dead or injured sea turtle, please call FWC at 888-404-3922

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES EVER TOUCH OR DO ANYTHING TO AN EGG ON THE BEACH!

BEACH REGULATIONS INCLUDE:

*No dogs (pets) on any beach. *If holes on beach are dug, they must be filled in fully.
*Remove all furniture, equipment and trash from beach every day. *No glass is allowed on the beach.

THE CITY OF ANNA MARIA STRICTLY ENFORCES ITS NOISE ORDINANCES

Excessive noises in the City are enforced based upon Sec. 26-86, 26-88, 26-90, 26-91, 26-94, etc. Fines for Noise Violations start at \$500. Pool, spa, hot tub quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
