## SF1408/HF1441-Fixed Wireless Statute Change

- Current law considers a home or business served if they have wireline service that meets state speed goals.
- This bill would add "or fixed wireless" into statute and allow homes within range of a fixed wireless tower to count as served.
- Bill is introduced every year; we play defense against it every year.
- Homes can be within range of a tower and not have service.
  - Topography; vegetation; cloud/fog cover.

## SF1523/HF1564-Fiber Optic Cable Tax Exemption

Association *of* Minnesota Counties

- Fiber optic cable and conduit purchased for use in Minnesota is tax exempt.
- Mostly a benefit to the ISPs, but could bring costs down for a project, allowing dollars to go further.
- Timeline: any products purchased between July 1, 2017 and July 1, 2023. Must be submitted by December 31, 2023.
- Incentivizes using the best technology available.
- Bipartisan support.
