Policy Committee Broadband Update

### How much money is available?

- 2021 Legislative session:
  - \$70 million from state's ARPA Capital Projects Fund (CPF)
- 2022 Legislative session:
  - \$50 million state general funds
  - \$60 million additional ARPA CPF
    - Up to \$30m for 75% state contribution pilot program
    - Up to \$15m for line extension pilot program
    - Up to \$15m for mapping
- \$100m coming from IIJA + estimated \$550m additional
- OBD estimates \$1.3 billion needed to connect rest of state



### Policy Committee Broadband Update

### Rural Digital Opportunity Fund (RDOF) Update

- In 2021, the FCC began the RDOF program and awarded \$400 million to MN for rural broadband expansion.
- LTD Broadband won preliminary reverse auctions totaling \$311 million. Starlink won \$8 million.
- The areas "won" by LTD/Starlink were locked out of state funding opportunities until this summer.
- During the review of the applications, the FCC revoked LTD and Starlink funding, leaving a \$320m gap in funding.



Policy Committee Broadband Update

### IIJA Broadband Expansion, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) program Update

- NTIA oversees the program.
- \$100m guaranteed; early estimate of additional \$550m.
- Funding will be deployed through OBD and our existing grant program.
- NTIA announced this week funding will be delayed until mapping is complete.
- Funding contingent on new maps in development by FCC.
  Counties can challenge first FCC maps (ISP provided info) with their own service maps.

### **How Can Counties Challenge FCC Maps?**

- Submit a challenge online if you have broadband service maps in your county (see document in your packets)
- https://help.bdc.fcc.gov/hc/en-us
  - A location that meets the Commission's definition of a Broadband Serviceable Location is missing from the Fabric.
  - A location's broadband serviceability is incorrectly identified.
  - Information such as the address or unit count for the location is incorrect.
  - The location's placement its geographic coordinates is incorrect.



Policy Committee Broadband Update

### What's next?

- Broadband funding should remain a priority for AMC.
- Nearly 25% of rural communities lack access to 100mbps/20mbps speeds.
- Monitor developments in FCC and NTIA programs and mapping.
- Watch for emerging issues like affordability.
