

BENZIE COUNTY DOG LICENSING PROGRAM

Benzie County sells either a one-year license or a three-year license based on the length of the dog's rabies. Expiration of a dog license is based on the expiration of the rabies, meaning it expires on the LAST DAY OF THE MONTH that the rabies vaccine was given. If the license is not purchased by the last day of the month, the license will be considered delinquent on the first day of the next month and a delinquent charge of \$30.00 will be added to the cost of the license.

License fees will be as follows:

	<u>One-year</u>	<u>Three-year</u>
Spayed/Neutered	\$ 10.00	\$ 25.00
Non-Spayed/Neutered	\$ 20.00	\$ 55.00

As a courtesy we will mail out renewal reminders. They will be mailed out the month before the license expires(which is the month the rabies expires).

Rabies expiration must be valid at the time of sale. The length of the Dog License will be determined by the YEAR of the rabies expiration.
