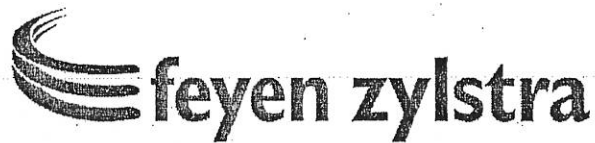

RE: Structured Cabling Budget

#### Structured Cabling

- All structured cabling work will adhere to "The Maples, Benzie County Medical Care Facility, Structured Wiring Specifications" dated July 7, 2014
- Budget is based on installing up to 387 new CAT6 cables in new addition (251 Data & 136 Voice)
- Cable counts are based on "Exhibit D" dated July 7, 2014
- All CAT6 cables will originate in upper level IT rooms
- We will install a j-hook cable support system for all data cables
- Cables will be properly terminated on both ends and installed in flush mount faceplates
- All cables will be non-plenum rated
- Patch cables will not be provided by Feyen Zylstra
- We will fire block all penetrations that we create during the installation of the cables
- All cabling will be secured with Velcro
- All copper cables will be properly supported, terminated, labeled and certified

#### Backbone Cabling

- All backbone cabling will adhere to "Exhibit A" dated July 7, 2014
- Between the MDF and each IDF we will install 25 pair CAT3 and CAT6a cables (quantities will be based on what is indicated in "Exhibit A" dated July 7, 2014)
- 25 pair cables will be terminated on 66 punch down blocks with Amphenol connectors in each IT room
- We will install Amphenol patch cables from the 66 blocks to 48 port Amphenol patch panels in each IT room
- The CAT6a cables will terminate on a CAT6a patch panel in each IT room

#### Coax Cabling

- All coax cabling work will adhere to "The Maples, Benzie County Medical Care Facility, Structured Wiring Specifications" dated July 7, 2014
- We will install up to 90 RG6 cables for TV locations
- We will install a backbone coax cable between IT rooms
- All RG6 coax cables will originate in lower level IT rooms
- Backbone coax cable will be provided by Charter
- Splitters will also be provided/installed by Charter
- All RG6 cables will be terminated with F connectors
