



RECREATION NEWS & NOTIFICATION METHODS

Recreation news and program cancellation notification will be communicated via the new GovDelivery system implemented by the Township. In order to receive communication via this new method you must register via the Township's website. Once registered you will receive email and/or text message notification when new brochures, flyers and recreation events are posted. The Recreation Department will use GovDelivery to notify participants of any class cancellations due to weather or other issues.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THIS FREE SERVICE:

- 1. Go to the township website www.branchburg.nj.us
- 2. Click on the "email updates" icon in the upper right corner
- 3. Enter your email address and create a password
- 4. Subscribe to the "recreation" section (and any other items that you may wish to receive information about)
- 5 Click on "subscriber preferences"
- 6. It should list the items you subscribed to and your primary email address
- 7. Under "secondary email address" you can either put a second email address to receive the information or, if you desire, you can use your mobile number. If the later, click the "wireless alerts preferred" box. The number to enter will be your 10 digit mobile number plus your carriers info (see the "more info" link for the carrier extensions)
- 8. Once you have entered all the information simply click save at the bottom of the page


