USFWS Partners Program - Park Shore Prairie



Did you know that the US Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) partnered locally with private landowners in a grassland restoration project right here in Cassopolis? Approximately 50 acres of the former Park Shore Golf Course were transformed into a prairie containing native plants and trees, enhancing local and migratory birds, pollinators and wildlife. During the summer of 2021, the private land was planted with more than 25 native species of warm season grass and wildflower seed. Over the next several years the land will bloom into a beautiful prairie and enhanced grassland area, providing a diverse habitat for wildlife critical to our local ecosystem. The USFWS Partners Program focuses on helping to ensure that elements of our common heritage such as wildlife, plantlife, and a healthy ecosystem will be there for future generations.
