Skiing, Snow Tubing, & Stargazing



Dr. T.K. Lawless Park, nine miles east of Cassopolis, has tons of amenities for year-round fun! Shake off those winter blues and explore seven miles of groomed cross-country skiing trails with lake views and scenic lookout points. If you're looking for something more thrilling, borrow a park-provided inner tube and try out snow tubing!

This 820 acre park is extra special as it is a designated International Dark Sky Park, making it an ideal place to stargaze and view astronomical wonders in the night sky. There are only two International Dark Sky Parks in the entire state of Michigan; Dr. T.K. Lawless Park and Headlands County Park near Mackinaw City.
