## WHAT IS HAPPENING IN THE VILLAGE?

### ➔ Trash Rate Increase



Effective April 15th the trash rate increased 3% in accordance with Michiana Recycling and Disposal's contracted rate. The regular trash rate will increase from \$16.88 to \$17.39, an increase of \$0.50.

**Trash and recycling carts must be removed from the street by 10am the day after pick up.**

### ➔ Memorial Flags



Volunteers are needed! Join us at 10am on Saturday, May 27th in Prospect Hill Cemetery to place flags on the graves of those who died in service to our country.

### ➔ Holiday Closure



The Cassopolis Municipal Complex will be closed on Monday, May 29th in observance of Memorial Day.

### Village Clean Up



Dumpsters will be located at Cass County Fairgrounds Thursday, April 27th through Sunday, April 30th 9am-5pm. Proof of village residency is required. No tires or hazardous waste.

### Delinquent Utilities



Any account for village provided utilities (water, sewer, trash) that is 6 months delinquent and unpaid by June 1st will be assessed to village property taxes.

### Hydrant Flushing



DPW will be flushing fire hydrants the first week of May. Hydrant flushing is an important part of annual maintenance, ensuring they work properly and removing mineral deposits that may occur inside the water distribution pipes.

Flushing may cause reduced water pressure and/or temporarily discolored water. In the case of discolored water, turn on several cold water taps in your home to allow new water to work its way into your pipes. Let the water run for several minutes until the discoloration is gone and the water runs clear. Although discolored water is safe, it is not recommended to use for laundry as it can stain clothing.

## Dear Valued Customer,

As part of our recent acquisition of Michiana Recycling and Disposal Services, LRS is proud to introduce a new curbside recycling service for the Village of Cassopolis. Residents will now have a separate 95-gallon cart for recycling materials, which will diminish contamination and improve sustainability efforts. These new carts will be delivered the week of March 13, 2023. **Beginning the week of March 27, 2023, please use your new recycling cart and discontinue use of the yellow bags.**

### RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Collection will be every other week on your current waste collection day.
- Carts must be curbside by 7 AM on your designated collection day
- All recycling materials must be loosely INSIDE of the carts, materials should not be placed in plastic bags
- Containers should be placed 3 feet apart & 3 feet from any obstruction
- Holiday service will be provided one day later than regular collection if the holiday falls Sunday through Friday
