Stone Lake Beach Expansion



The Village has been awarded a \$1,000,000 Spark Grant from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources. This grant will be used towards phase two of Stone Lake Beach. Of the 462 communities that applied statewide, only 21 were selected for funding. Many thanks to all who provided feedback on the public engagement survey and helped the Village's application score competitively. Village staff continue to pursue additional grant funding opportunities for this project.
