

WATER SERVICE MATERIAL INSPECTION

In an effort to eliminate lead water services, the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) is requiring public water suppliers to inventory the existing water service line materials within their system. To do this, a sample of 20% of customer service lines have been selected for inspection.

The Village of Cassopolis was awarded a grant from EGLE to visually inspect 83 of the 413 services within the system. Inspections include uncovering the water service to visually inspect, photograph, and document the service line material. Inspections also include visual identification of the water service within 18-inches inside the building. See the diagram below, provided by EGLE, for the locations required for inspection.



In order to complete the inspections at locations 1 and 2 indicated in the diagram, the Village must have your permission and cooperation to enter the premises. To allow the inspections at locations 1 and 2, please fill out the contact information section, sign this letter, and return to the Village Office, 121 N. Disbrow Street, Cassopolis, 49031. Village Public Works Staff will conduct interior service line inspections and will coordinate this schedule with you. Village Public Works staff are currently scheduling interior inspections with a goal to complete all interior inspections by December 2023. The exterior inspections will be completed per the Village Contractor's schedule, which will be between June 2023 and April 2024. You will be notified by flyer or door tag from the contractor at least three days before the exterior inspections are completed.

Exterior visual inspections will include a small hole (approximately 8 - 12 inches wide) dug via hydro excavation to expose the water service line. Photos of the service will be taken as well as a general location photo looking toward the building. The contractor will fill the holes with sand the same day as the inspection occurs, and will seed and topsoil disturbed areas within 1 week of the inspection. If the inspection requires the disturbance of hard structures such as pavement or concrete, this restoration will occur once all inspections are completed.

If your water service is found to be lead or galvanized steel previously connected to lead, you will be notified by the Village within 30 days of this finding, according to the Michigan Safe Drinking Water Act, 1976 PA 399. If your water service line is any other material you will not be notified. If you would like to know the findings of your service line inspection, please contact the Project Engineer.
