Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. by Chairman S. Mangum.

Approval of Agenda: DeAngelis motioned to accept the agenda, seconded by Oglebay and unanimously approved by the board.

Approval of Minutes of March 26, 2024: K. Mangum motioned to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Oglebay and unanimously approved by the board.

Public Input: There was no public input.

New Business/Updates/Action Items:

- Mileur presented the Litter Control Coordinator’s Report.
 - Litter Cleanups/Enforcement
 - Two signs that read “This Area is Under Surveillance” were recently installed on Liz Lane by the Hospitality and Beautification Dept. Williams and Mileur both agreed that since the placement of the signs, there has been a decrease in litter.
 - Monthly Cleanups
 - The March Monthly Cleanup to be held along the second half of Liz Lane on March 28th was cancelled due to inclement weather.
 - The April Monthly Cleanup is scheduled for April 25th at Sherwood Parks 1 & 2.
 - Education
 - In April, The Go Green Club Leader at Conway Elementary School distributed the KCB Litter Kits to the club members, and they conducted a cleanup on the school grounds. The members have been submitting

photos to Mileur showing that they're using their kits and picking up litter in their neighborhoods.

- The Conway Elementary School's April Family Sustainability Challenge is to encourage the planting of native plants. KCB provided the students with a pack of Black Eyed Susan seeds to plant at home. Many students have participated and submitted their photos for posting on both their schools and KCB's Facebook pages. KCB rewards the participating students with miscellaneous giveaways.
- KCB participated in Coastal Carolina University's annual Farmers' Market and Earth Fair on April 17th.
- On April 19th, Mileur participated in Conway High School's Career Fair. She created and displayed a slide presentation explaining her position as Conway's Litter Control Coordinator and included information about Keep Conway Beautiful and her role as Executive Director.
- Miscellaneous
 - Great American Cleanup
 - The Conway Great American Cleanup Day will be on Saturday, May 18th, from 8 am to noon at the Conway Sports and Fitness Center. Over 70 city employees have volunteered, and a few high school students that need community service hours have expressed interest in participating.
 - KCB Otter Mascot
 - Rascal's introduction is scheduled for May 6th at the City Council Meeting. He will be introduced as a new city employee.
 - New Event Idea
 - Mileur created a kit to be used as a giveaway at future events called the Litter Prevention Trio. The free kit will consist of a truck bed tarp, portable ashtray and car litter bag.
