# **ISSUE**:

**Final Reading of Ordinance** #**ZA2025-03-17** (**A**), to rezone approximately 0.74+/- acres of property located on Sixteenth Ave, between Elm Street and Elizabeth Street (PIN 338-11-01-0049) from the Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district to the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) district.

# **BACKGROUND:**

The applicant submitted a rezoning application for the subject property in late December 2024. The property is already in the city limits, zoned Low/Medium-Density Residential. The property is currently vacant. The proposed use of the property has not been disclosed by the applicant; however, the applicant is requesting to rezone the property to the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) district.

# **Zoning District of Subject Property:**

Per Section 3.2.9 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO), the NC district is intended to provide small scale retail and service uses for nearby residential areas. Dimensional requirements and design standards of the NC district are intended to promote compatibility to surrounding residential areas and accommodate pedestrian use and access. Strip commercial development, designed primarily to accommodate vehicular access and parking, and development that is insensitive or incompatible with the scale and character of the surrounding residential areas, is discouraged in this district.

# Village Corridor Overlay(VCO) district:

This property is also located within the Village Corridor Overlay (VCO). Per Section 3.4.3 of the UDO, the intent of the VCO shall be used to promote compact, pedestrian-scale development with residential, neighborhood commercial, professional, and office uses. The Village Corridor Overlay zoning shall include all properties fronting on minor arterials and collector streets designated on the zoning map.

Additionally, per *Section 6.5.3, A. – Purpose*, of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO), "the VCO is established to provide unified development that promotes a sense of place and provides opportunities to develop projects engineered to be compatible with the carrying capacity of minor arterials and collector streets."

# **Surrounding uses/Zoning Districts:**

A portion of the property abuts property zoned Highway Commercial (HC) and abuts property zoned Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) on one side that is used commercially (was occupied by a cosmetology school at one time) and the other side is also zoned R-1 but currently vacant. Behind the property is a split-zoned parcel, zoned R-1 and HC, with the frontage of that property being on Elizabeth Street. There is also a 10-ft construction easement that runs along one side of the subject property that appears to have been created when additional right-of-way was deeded to SCDOT in 2007.

# **CITY OF CONWAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:**

The future land use map of the *Comprehensive Plan* also identifies the property as Neighborhood Commercial (NC).

# **PLANNING COMMISSION:**

Planning Commission held the required public hearing on the request at their February 6<sup>th</sup> meeting and recommended approval of the request to rezone the property to NC.

# **ORDINANCE #ZA2025-03-17 (A)**

# AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE APPROXIMATELY 0.74+/- ACRES OF PROPERTY LOCATED ON SIXTEENTH AVE, BETWEEN ELM STREET & ELIZABETH STREET (PIN 338-11-01-0049) FROM THE CITY OF CONWAY LOW/MEDIUM-DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (R-1) DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF CONWAY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL (NC) DISTRICT.

- **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Title 6, Chapter 29 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, the City of Conway enacted the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Conway, South Carolina; and
- **WHEREAS,** Article 13, Section 13.1.7 of the City of Conway Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) provides that regulations, restrictions, and boundaries set forth in the UDO may be amended, supplemented, changed, or repealed in accordance with S.C. Code §6-29-760; and
- WHEREAS, a petition has been submitted to rezone approximately 0.74+/- (total) acres located on Sixteenth Ave, between Elm Street and Elizabeth Street (PIN 338-11-01-0049) from the City of Conway Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district to the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) district; and
- WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Conway, on February 6, 2025, held the required public hearing to discuss the request to rezone from the Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district to the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) district, and made their recommendation; and
- **WHEREAS,** City Council determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Conway and its citizens to approve the rezoning petition as presented. Therefore, be it
- **ORDAINED,** by Conway City Council, in Council duly assembled, that the zoning boundaries of the Official Map of the City of Conway, together with explanatory matter herein, be revised as follows:

Rezone approximately 0.74+/- (total) acres located on Sixteenth Ave, between Elm Street and Elizabeth Street (PIN 338-11-01-0049) from the Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district to the Neighborhood Commercial (NC); and be it further

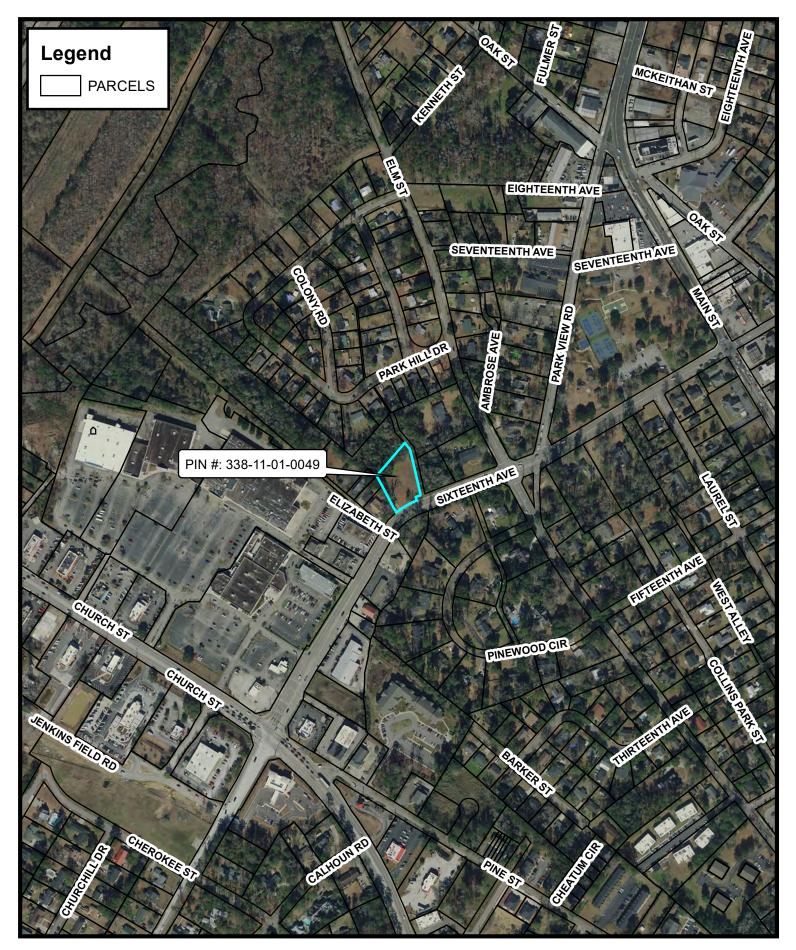
- **ORDAINED,** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

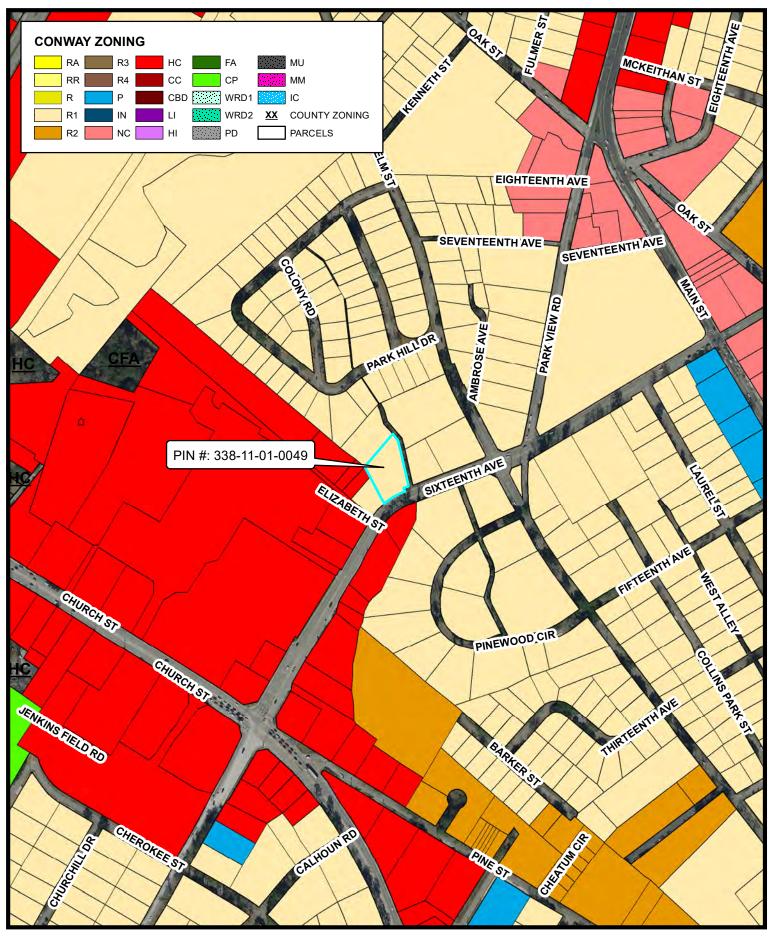






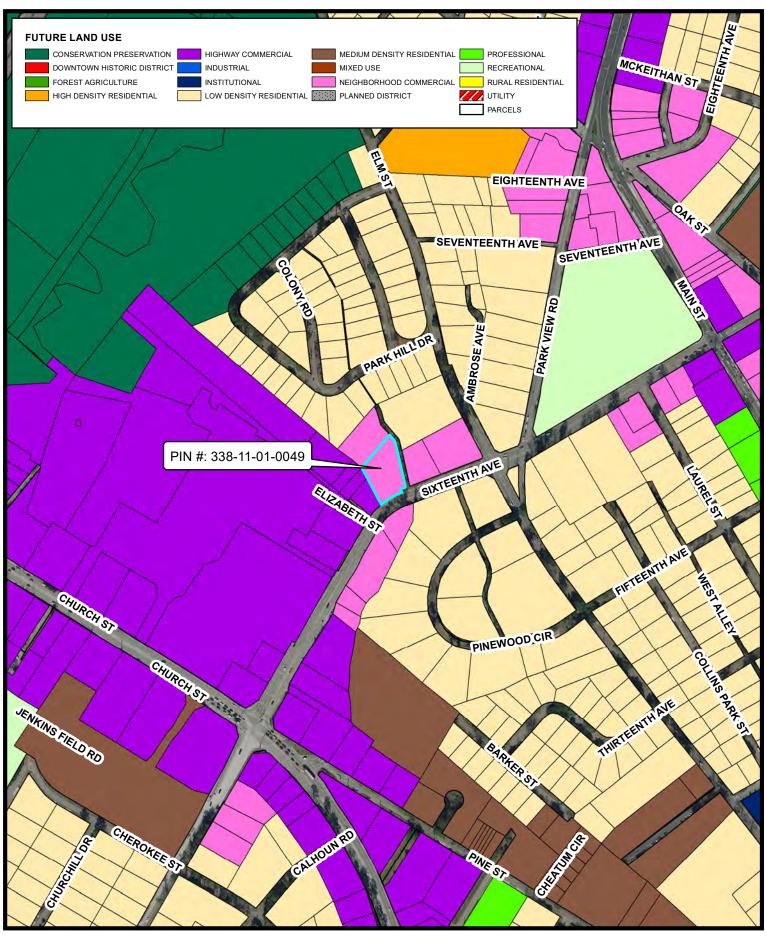






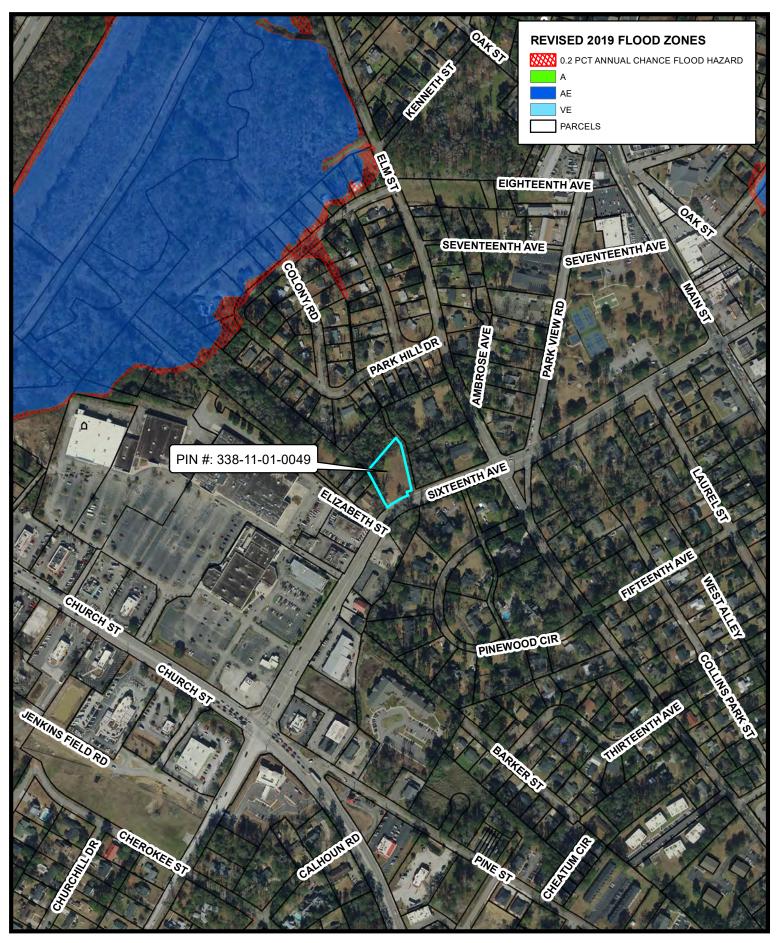

# **ISSUE:**

**Final Reading of Ordinance** #**ZA2025-03-17** (**B**), to annex approximately 0.37 acres located at 116 Clemson Road (PIN 383-10-01-0018), and rezone from the Horry County Residential, no mobile homes allowed (SF10) district to the City of Conway Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district.

# **BACKGROUND:**

The annexation application was submitted by the property owner, Margaret Lisa Wines, as a requirement for a name change to the city utility services account. According to Horry County Land Records, the deed was transferred into the owner's name on December 2, 2024. The property is within the Coastal Heights subdivision near Hwy 544. There is an existing single-family structure on the property. Restrictive covenants were recorded for this property February 6, 2025.

The adjacent property was annexed into the City in 2022. Several other properties within the Coastal Heights subdivision have been annexed over the years; most of them being on Clemson Road, and some located on University and Lander Drive.

# **CITY OF CONWAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:**

The Future Land Use Map of the *Comprehensive Plan* identifies this property as <u>Low/Medium Density</u> Residential (R-1).

The intent of the R-1 District is to provide for the preservation and expansion of areas for low to medium density, detached single-family residential development in the City of Conway. The district shall present a relatively spacious character, promote quiet, livable neighborhoods, and prohibit uses that are incompatible with the residential nature of the surrounding area.

# **CITY COUNCIL:**

City Council approved First Reading of the ordinance at their February 18th meeting.

# **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends approval of Final reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-03-17 (B).

# **ORDINANCE #ZA2025-03-17 (B)**

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX APPROXIMATELY 0.37 ACRES OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 116 CLEMSON ROAD (PIN 383-10-01-0018), AND REQUEST TO REZONE FROM THE HORRY COUNTY RESIDENTIAL, NO MOBILE HOMES ALLOWED (SF10) DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF CONWAY LOW/MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT (R-1) DISTRICT.

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CONWAY:

# **SECTION 1. FINDINGS:**

A petition has been submitted to the City Council of the City of Conway to annex approximately 0.37 acres of property described herein and represented on a map. 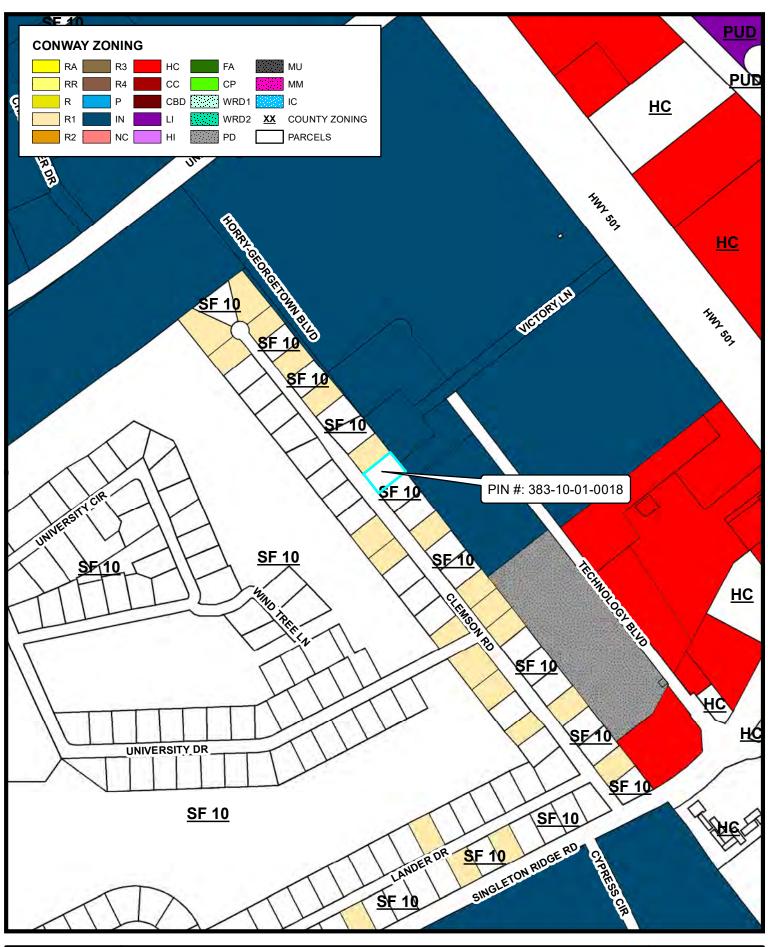






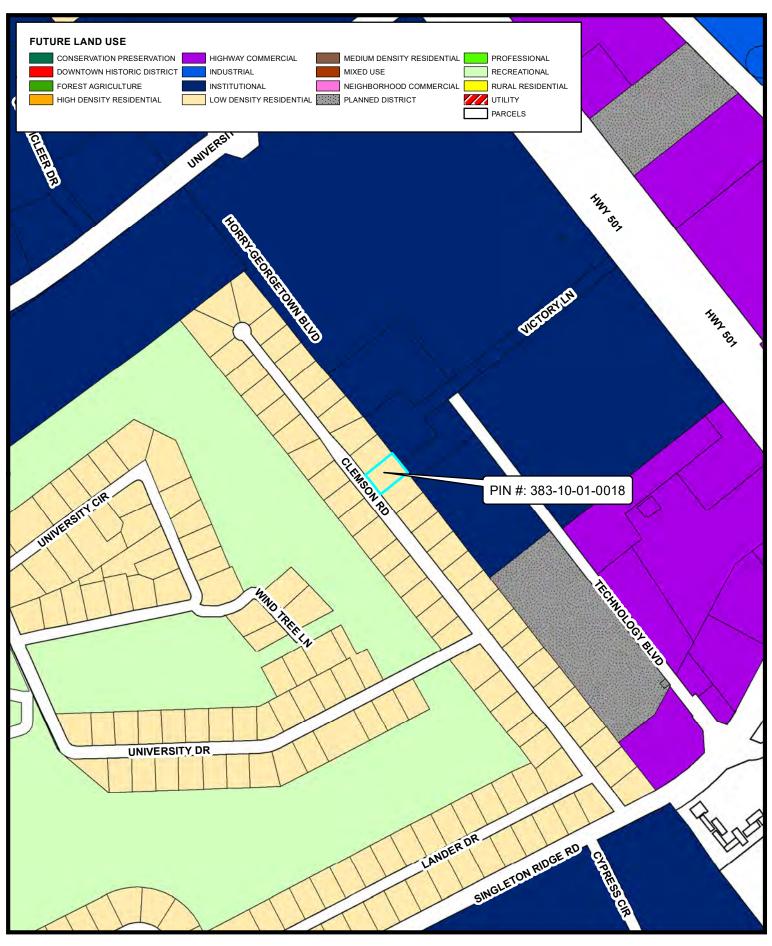






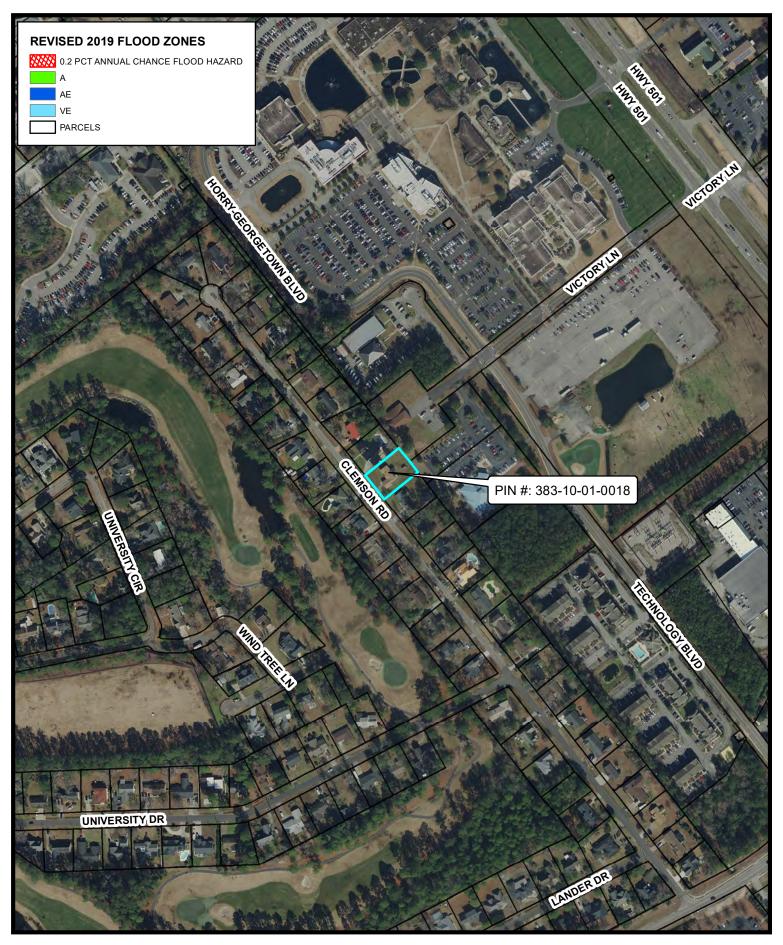

**WHEREAS**, the Law Enforcement and Support Act (the Act), beginning at § 23-20-10 et seq. of the South Carolina Code of Laws, § 23-20-30 provides "Any county, incorporated municipality, or other political subdivision of this State may enter into mutual aid agreements for the proper and prudent exercise of public safety functions. All agreements must adhere to the requirements contained in § 23-20-40"; and

WHEREAS, § 23-20-20(4) of the Act defines a Mutual Aid Agreement as "any agreement entered into on behalf of a law enforcement agency in this State for the purpose of providing the proper and prudent exercise of public safety functions across jurisdictional lines, including, but not limited to, multijurisdictional task forces, criminal investigations, patrol services, crowd control, traffic control and safety, and other emergency service situations. Such agreements must not be permitted for the sole purpose of speed enforcement"; and

# **WHEREAS** § 23-20-20 also defines the following as:

- (1) "Law enforcement agency" means any state, county, municipal, or local law enforcement authority that enters into an agreement for the procurement of law enforcement support services.
- (2) "Law enforcement provider" means any in-state or out-of-state law enforcement authority that provides law enforcement services to a law enforcement agency pursuant to this chapter.
- (3) "Law enforcement services" means any law enforcement assistance or service performed by a certified law enforcement officer; and
- (4) "Mutual aid agreement" means any agreement entered into on behalf of a law enforcement agency in this State for the purpose of providing the proper and prudent exercise of public safety functions across jurisdictional lines, including, but not limited to, multijurisdictional task forces, criminal investigations, patrol services, crowd control, traffic control and safety, and other emergency service situations. Such agreements must not be permitted for the sole purpose of speed enforcement.

# WHEREAS § 23-20-40 provides

- (A) All mutual aid agreements for law enforcement services must be in writing and include, but may not be limited to, the following:
  - (1) a statement of specific services to be provided;
  - (2) specific language dealing with financial agreements between the parties;
  - (3) specification of the records to be maintained concerning the performance of services to be provided to the agency;
  - (4) language dealing with the duration, modification, and termination of the agreement;
  - (5) specific language dealing with the legal contingencies for any lawsuits or the payment of damages that arise from the provided services;
  - (6) a stipulation as to which law enforcement authority maintains control over the law enforcement provider's personnel;
  - (7) specific arrangements for the use of equipment and facilities; and
  - (8) specific language dealing with the processing of requests for information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act for public safety functions performed or arising under these agreements.
- (B) Except as provided in subsection (C), a mutual aid agreement entered into on behalf of a law enforcement authority must be approved by the appropriate governing bodies of each concerned county, incorporated municipality, or other political subdivision of this State. Agreements entered into are executed between governing bodies, and, therefore, may last until the agreement is terminated by a participating party of the agreement.
- (C) An elected official whose office was created by the Constitution or by general law of this State is not required to seek approval from the elected official's governing body in order to participate in mutual aid agreements.

NOW THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, SECTION 23-20-10 ET SEQ, THE NORTH MYRTLE BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT (NMBPD) AND CONWAY POLICE THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

# 1. <u>TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF OFFICERS, SPECIFIC SERVICES TO BE</u> PROVIDED, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT:

(a) CPD shall provide Officers on a temporary basis to provide law enforcement services in the City of North Myrtle Beach, South Carolina during the Memorial Day Bike Event beginning on May 22, 2025 through May 26, 2025. The Agreement shall be effective for the period beginning at 12:00 a.m. on May 23, 2025, and ending at 11:59 p.m. on May 26, 2025. However, the CPD shall not be required to begin providing assistance until May 23, 2025 continuing through May 26, 2025 unless otherwise requested by the City of North Myrtle Beach to

commence providing services prior to May 23, 2025 during the above referenced effective period.

- **(b)** The specific law enforcement services that the CPD shall provide include, but are not limited to, patrol services, crowd control, and traffic control.
  - (c) This agreement shall terminate, as indicated in paragraph 1(a) on Monday, May 26, 2025 at 11:59 pm. This agreement shall not be modified unless both parties consent, in writing, to a modification. The terms of the modification shall be in writing and shall become a part of the original Agreement.

# 2. <u>AUTHORITY</u>

- (a) The North Myrtle Beach City Council has approved this Agreement and has authorized the CPD to request the temporary transfer of law enforcement officers from the CPD to the extent of available personnel and equipment not required for the adequate protection of the remainder of City of Conway. The Police Chief or commanding officer of the CPD shall determine the amount of personnel and equipment available for law enforcement aid in North Myrtle Beach. The decision of the Police Chief or the commanding officer of the CPD shall be final.
- (b) The City of Conway authorizes the Chief of the CPD or his designee to render temporary law enforcement aid to the NMBPD to the extent of available personnel and equipment not required for adequate protection of the remainder of the City of Conway.
- (c) Law enforcement officers from the CPD acting under this Agreement shall be commanded by superior authority from within the CPD to maintain the peace or perform duties in the municipality of North Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. While in North Myrtle Beach, officers from the CPD shall be under the direction and authority of a designated person from the CPD. The designated person from the CPD with authority over the officers from the CPD shall in turn be under the direction and authority of Chief of Police for the NMBPD or the Chief's designee. Officers from the CPD transferred to perform law enforcement duties within the City of North Myrtle Beach shall have all powers and authority of a law enforcement officer employed by the City of North Myrtle Beach. The bond for any officer transferred from the CPD shall include coverage for his/her activity in the municipality of North Myrtle Beach in the same manner and to the same extent provided by bonds of officers employed by the NMBPD.

# **3 COMPENSATION**

The NMBPD shall provide a fifty dollar (\$50) per diem to each officer from the CPD transferred to the municipality of North Myrtle Beach pursuant to this Agreement. In addition, the NMBPD shall provide lodging for each officer from the CPD transferred to the municipality of North Myrtle Beach pursuant to this Agreement. The NMBPD shall also reimburse the CPD the rate of salary or the hourly rate of wages for each officer transferred from the CPD. Such reimbursement for each officer shall include any

overtime and any applicable state and federal taxes and SCPORS contributions. CPD shall submit an invoice to the NMBPD within thirty (30) days from May 26, 2025 regarding reimbursement for officers transferred pursuant to this Agreement. Reimbursement shall not include travel expenses.

Other than the compensation to be paid to the CPD as indicated above, the NMBPD shall not be obligated to pay additional remuneration to the CPD however, in in the event any extraordinary cost is incurred by the CPD in the rendering of law enforcement services pursuant to this Agreement, the CPD may submit a request for compensation to off-set any extraordinary cost. The NMBPD shall not unreasonably withhold payment to the CPD for any extraordinary costs incurred by the CPD while rendering law enforcement services pursuant to this Agreement.

The temporary transfer of officers from the CPD to the NMBPD pursuant to this Agreement shall in no manner affect or reduce the compensation, pension, or retirement rights of transferred or assigned officers and such officers shall continue to be paid by the City of Conway where such officers are permanently employed.

# 4. LIABILTY

- (a) To the extent permitted by law, and without waiving sovereign immunity, each agency shall be responsible for any and all claims, demands, suits, actions, damages and causes of action related to or arising out of or in any way connected with its own actions and the actions of its personnel in providing law enforcement services under this agreement.
- (b) The NMBPD and the City of North Myrtle Beach shall not be responsible for reimbursing any amounts paid or due as benefits to employees of the CPD or the City of Conway under the terms of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Act due to personal injury or death occurring while such employees are engaged in rendering aid under this Agreement. The NMBPD and the City of Conway shall be responsible for payment of compensation and benefits only to their respective employees.
- (c) All individuals retain all compensation, pension, retirement and disability rights while performing duties in accordance with this agreement, and all officers shall continue to be paid by the entity where they are permanently employed as of the dates services are rendered.
- (d) This Agreement shall not be construed as, or deemed to be, an agreement for the benefit of any third party or parties. No third party or parties shall have any right of action under this agreement for any cause of action whatsoever.

# 5. EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES

The CPD may utilize equipment from its own agency, if approved of by the Chief of Police for the NMBPD or his designee, in carrying out law enforcement services pursuant to this Agreement.

# 6. <u>RECORDS</u>

In the event that it is necessary for any officer with the CPD to issue a uniform traffic ticket, prepare an incident report, traffic accident report, and/or prepare any document(s) necessary for the issuance of an arrest warrant, the originals of the above stated documents shall remain with and be maintained by the NMBPD. In the event it is necessary for an officer with the CPD to return to the City of North Myrtle Beach to aid in the prosecution of any traffic citation issued or arrest warrant obtained by, or with the assistance of, any officer from the CPD while he/she was performing law enforcement services pursuant to this Agreement, such officer shall reasonably cooperate with the NMBPD to return to North Myrtle Beach for the purpose of providing testimony if the matter is to be disposed of via bench trial or jury trial. The NMBPD shall pay for the officer's mileage at the prevailing IRS mileage rate.

# 7. PROCESSING REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION PURSUANT TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

Any requests for information submitted to the City of North Myrtle Beach and/or the North Myrtle Beach Police Department pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) regarding public safety functions performed or arising under these agreements shall be processed by the City of North Myrtle Beach. Any requests for information submitted to THE CONWAY POLICE DEPARTMENT pursuant to the South Carolina Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) regarding public safety functions performed or arising under these agreements shall be processed by CONWAY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Blain called the meeting to order. Joel Wilson of Ekklesia Christian Church gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The requirements for posting notice of this meeting under South Carolina's Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) were met.

- **A.** Presentation of Employee of the Month for February 2025 Public Works Dudley presented Shawn Dawson as the February 2025 Employee of the Month.
- **B.** Presentation of a Resolution honoring the Conway Kiwanis Club for their 60<sup>th</sup> Annual Pancake Breakfast and Supper Blain presented members of the Conway Kiwanis Club with a resolution honoring them for their 60<sup>th</sup> Annual Pancake Breakfast and Supper.
- C. Conway Downtown Alive Annual Visitor Center Update Howard, Executive Director of Conway Downtown Alive updated Council on Events, Visitors Center, Fifth and Main, Social Media, Electronic Registration System, Staff & Ambassadors, Mural Guide, Rainy Day Guide, Community Events, Historic Tours, Visitor Parking Tag Program, Map Distribution, Downtown Marketing Campaign, Ad Placement, Geo-Fencing, Visitor Center Page, Gullah Geechee Community Day, Waccamaw Sportsmen's Expo, and Groovin on the Green.
- D. Discussion of a request to rezone approximately 7.30+/- acres of property located on (North) Main Street and Chicora Blvd (PIN 338-03-02-0006) from the Highway Commercial (HC) district to the High-Density Residential (R-3) district. Hucks stated that this application was submitted last month. The property is currently zoned HC and is consistent with the city's future land use map. The requested zoning is R-3. The property is also located within the Gateway Corridor Overlay. Staff discussed the proposed rezoning with the applicant, and it is staffs understanding that multifamily is proposed to be developed on the property. Adjacent uses include a single-family development, vacant property on the opposite side of Chicora Blvd, zoned HC, that was previously proposed to develop a KJ's. Property across Main Street is zoned HC as well. Hucks said that Planning Commission is scheduled to hold the public hearing and consider the request at the March 6 meeting and that staff will forward their recommendation with first reading.

# **SECOND/FINAL READING:**

Second Reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-01-21 (A), granting a non-exclusive franchise agreement to Project Smashburger Mobile Food Truck at the parking lot adjacent to Fourth Ave and Kingston Street (near Palmetto Taps). Hucks stated that this request received first reading on January 6 and second reading was deferred at the January 21 meeting due to concerns with a mobile food vendor securing parking spaces in an area with limited parking. The applicant

is still requesting permission to utilize this location but has amended the request to Fridays and Saturdays from 3-9 p.m., alternating days each week. Additionally, two different locations are now shown on the revised site plan if the parks in one of the locations are in use when the vendor arrives on those days. If approved, the agreement would be for a 6-month probationary period and would require the applicant to come back for approval of the full term of the franchise agreement in August of this year.

Council had concerns about traffic and the lack of parking in that area.

Blain asked for staff's recommendation. Hucks said that staff also had concerns with parking issues in this area and did not recommend approval of the franchise agreement.

<u>Motion:</u> Blain made a motion, seconded by Goldfinch to deny second reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-01-21 (A). <u>Vote:</u> Unanimous. Motion carried.

Goldfinch asked if this would preclude the applicant from bringing another request to be located in a different spot. Hucks said no.

# FIRST READING:

A. First Reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-03-17 (A) to rezone approximately 0.74+/- acres of property located on Sixteenth Avenue, between Elm Street and Elizabeth Street (PIN 338-11-01-0049) from the Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district to the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) district. Hucks stated that this request was discussed at the January 21 Council meeting. The applicant is requesting to rezone the property to NC, which is consistent with the city's future land use map. The property is currently zoned R-1 and is also within the Village Corridor Overlay district. Abutting uses include a cosmetology school, which is on property zoned R-1, a vacant split zoned parcel, split between R-1 and Highway Commercial, and another vacant parcel zoned R-1. Across from the property is a small vacant parcel zoned Highway Commercial as well as a R-1 parcel that contains a single-family residence. Hucks said that Planning Commission held the public hearing at their February 6 meeting, and recommended approval of the request. The request is consistent with the future land use map and well exceeds the minimum lot size for the NC district. Additionally, the NC district is more restrictive in terms of permitted uses than the HC district. Hucks said that staff recommended approval.

<u>Motion:</u> White made a motion, seconded by Blain to approve first reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-03-17 (A). **Vote:** Unanimous. Motion carried.

B. First Reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-03-17 (B) to annex approximately 0.37+/- acres of property located at 116 Clemson Rd (PIN 383-10-01-0018) from the Horry County Residential, no mobile homes allowed, (SF10) district to the City of Conway Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1) district. Hucks stated that this request was submitted as a result of the requirements to connect to city utility services. The property was transferred into the current owner's name in December of last year. The property is within the Coastal Heights subdivision, where several other parcels have been required to request annexation over the last few years. Coastal Heights is a relatively large development that also contains a golf course, with parcels stretching from Highway 544 to Technology Blvd. The city's future land use map identifies the property as R-1. There is

an existing single-family residence on the property. Hucks said that staff does recommend approval of the annexation.

<u>Motion:</u> Goldfinch made a motion, seconded by Butler to approve first reading of Ordinance #ZA2025-03-17 (B). <u>Vote:</u> Unanimous. Motion carried.

# **PUBLIC INPUT:**

There was no public input.

### **CITY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:**

Emrick informed Council of the following:

- Emrick thanked Jack Cooper and Tanner Stroud, the official Conway Gondoliers and thanked all the folks that made the gondola rides happen.
- Emrick reminded council that the Budget Retreat is in Rock Hill arriving on March 5 and leaving on March 7.
- Emrick said that department head reports tonight is from Timmy Williams in Hospitality and Beautification and from Chief Hendrick from the Fire Department.
- Emrick stated that there is one workshop item regarding a request to develop a parcel contiguous to the city limits.

<u>Hospitality and Beautification</u> – Williams gave Council a copy of the Annual Report for Keep Conway Beautiful. Williams said that the irrigation system inside Riverfront Park should be completed by April 1. Williams stated that the parking lot improvements at the Dog Park should be started at the beginning of the summer. Williams informed Council that from October 19-November 23 there were 20 volunteers that helped with the holiday season decorations for a total of 480 hours.

<u>Fire Department</u> – Hendrick updated Council on the Emergency Management saying that staff is preparing for an update to the Emergency Operations Plan that mostly will be general housekeeping items. Hendrick said that staff are preparing for the upcoming hurricane season. Hendrick said that with the recent snow event there were 6+ inches in Conway with no issues throughout the city as staff did not activate the EOC, but did move to OPCON 2 which is a readiness state. Hendrick said that our area could have possible freezing rain on Wednesday night, but no issues are expected.

Perzan updated Council with the following information:

# **COUNCIL INPUT:**

**Helms** thanked Smith and staff for the Father Daughter Dance and said that it gets better and better. Helms said that she and Blain represented Conway and attended the Gamecock Women's Basketball game where they met Dawn Staley.

**Butler** announced that the Conway High School boys' basketball team is the region champs and encouraged all to attend the playoffs at home this Friday.

**White** stated that Coach Hopkins, the head coach of the Conway High boys' basketball team was named the Region 6-AAAAA Coach of the Year.

**Goldfinch** said that he missed the Riverwalk Extension ribbon cutting but that it looked great, and that Conway was well represented. Goldfinch then talked about quality-of-life events and said that Porchfest, the one Howard talked about earlier, would be a quality-of-life event.

**Blain** echoed Helms delight in the Father Daughter Dance and bragged on the decorations. Blain said that the Riverwalk Extension ribbon cutting with the lights, fanfare, decorations, the entrance, gondola, along with everything else that staff continue to put together was great. Blain also thanked the volunteers. Blain said that she was asked to write a Proclamation for Black History month, and she said that she didn't respond like she should have, and time was an issue. Blain asked that this group be aware of the fact that this is Black History Month.

# **WORKSHOP:**

Twin Oaks Drive Annexation – Hucks informed Council that the applicant approached staff about the possibility of annexing property on Twin Oaks Drive. The proposed to be annexed property is contiguous to the Collins Jollie development, which is currently being developed as a conservation subdivision. The City's utility service area ends at the start of Twin Oaks Drive, which is directly off Highway 65, with two parcels on one side of Twin Oaks within the utility service area (water and sewer). The property proposed to be annexed is contiguous via land, abutting one of the developments within the Collins Jollie Conservation Subdivision; however, it is not contiguous via travel way. The closest property on Highway 65 that is within the city limits is the Hainer Place development; approximately 2 miles from the property proposing annexation. Twin Oaks Drive is a dead-end road and there would not be any connection via the Collins Jollie development that would connect this property to Collins Jollie Road. Being that it's not within the utility service area, future land use is not identified, although nearby properties that are within the service area are identified as Conservation Preservation (CP); likely due to either wetlands that are identified on those properties or flood zones that may exist. Aside from CP, other properties are identified as Rural Residential. Hucks said that the applicant has mentioned developing the property as a conservation subdivision, which staff supports any development

seeking to retain as much open space as possible – especially land encumbered by environmentally sensitive areas, staffs' concerns are primarily due to the distance between this property and the nearest property being within the city limits. Annexation of this property would create more donut holes, stretch city services and would slow response times for emergency services.

Council discussed the property being in the county versus being in the city, where the city would have control over the development. Council discussed the property being a Conservation Subdivision, creating a donut hole, service area, and access via roadways.

Council directed staff to work with the applicant to obtain preliminary sketch plans and/or proposals with enhancement fees.

#### **ISSUE:**

Discussion of a request to amend the Carsen's Ferry Planned Development (PD) district (f.n.a. Rivertown Landing PD), to amend the list of permitted uses on Commercial Tract "A", consisting of approximately 4.24+/- acres of property located on Riverport Drive (PIN 337-05-02-0004).

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Rivertown Landing Planned Development (PD) district, now Carsen's Ferry, was originally created in 2007 out of 28.55 acres off Hwy 501 at Riverport Dr. The stated purpose was to "create a walkable, mixed-use community featuring multi-family residential, civic, commercial, and office space in the City of Conway." Until 2015/2016, the only thing that had been developed in this community was the clubhouse and pool. Since its creation, the PD has been amended four (4) other times.

2010 amendment: Amended to increase the height allowance for Carsen's Ferry multifamily project

from 40 feet to 52 feet and reduce the total residential units from 108 to 86.

2017 amendment: removed all commercial and multifamily from the rear most parcels and replaced

them with single-family homes on 50 small individual lots. This created a traditional neighborhood layout / development style (*i.e.* The Village at Country Club) with 1 and 2-story traditional craftsman and low-country style homes

spaced closely together, ranging from 1,400 to 2,200 sq. ft.

2018 amendment: 3.5 acres of a designated as commercial was amended and added to allow

additional single-family residential, which now makes up phase 5 of the development, which contains an additional 18 single-family dwellings and with the same requirements as the previous 4 phases. This left approx. 1.5 acres of

Commercial acreage for commercial development.

2022 amendment: amended the permitted uses in what was remaining of Commercial Tract B to

include any use permitted in the Highway Commercial (HC) district.

**Proposed 2025 amendment:** amend the permitted uses on Commercial Tract "A", which includes

approx. 4.24+/- acres, to allow a combination of residential, professional, and other limited commercial uses on the upland portion of the property, or mixed-use development, leaving the remainder as open space and a master-planned

stormwater system.

#### **Current Zoning:**

The intent of the current zoning, a Planned Development (PD) district, per Section 3.3.2 of the UDO, is to provide for large-scale, quality development projects (3 acres and larger) with mixed land uses which create a superior environment through unified development and provide for the application of design ingenuity while protecting surrounding developments.

#### **COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:**

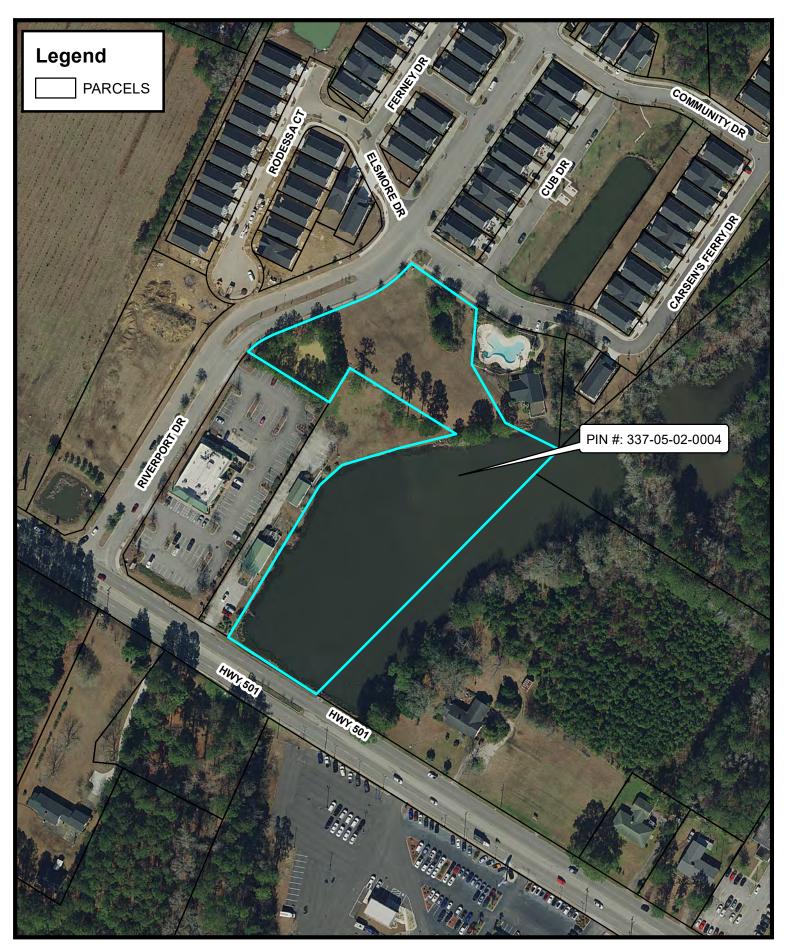
The future land use map of the comprehensive plan identifies the subject property as Planned Development (PD) and Conservation Preservation (CP). Per Section 3.2.15 of the UDO, the intent of the Conservation Preservation (CP) district is to provide needed open space for general outdoor and indoor recreational uses and to protect environmentally sensitive areas and flood prone areas from the encroachment of any residential, commercial, industrial, or other uses capable of adversely affecting the relatively undeveloped character of the district.

#### **PLANNING COMMISSION:**

The Technical Review Committee (TRC) is currently reviewing the proposed amendments. Planning Commission is scheduled to hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments at their April 3, 2025 meeting. If a recommendation is provided at that time, it will be forwarded to Council for first reading.

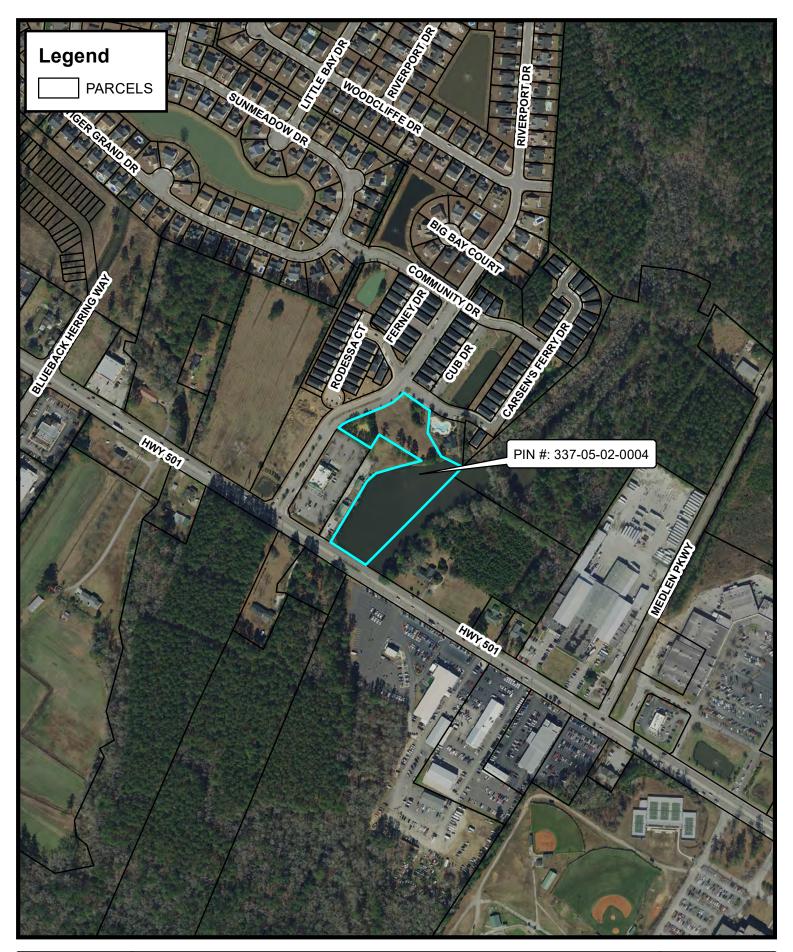

## Carsen's Ferry Planned Development (Rivertown Landing PDD)

Revision February 2025

#### Narrative

A revision to the existing Carsen's Ferry PD (Rivertown Landing PDD) is requested to change the name of Commercial Tract 'A' to Mixed Use Tract, and permit uses in the Mixed Use Tract as follows:

Allow a combination of residential, professional, and limited commercial (mixed use) on a portion of the upland, with accompanying parking and roadway. Leaving the remaining portion as open space and a master-planned stormwater system.

Commercial Tract 'A' (Mixed Use Tract) within Carsen's Ferry PD (Rivertown Landing PDD) is Horry County PIN#'s 337-05-02-0004. The owner is Michelle and Andy Christenson, 3550 Hwy 472, Conway, SC 29526. This tract is located along Community Drive, in the City of Conway.

The Rivertown Landing PDD was originally passed in 2007 with the intent of developing three commercial tracts and a multifamily tract consisting of 108 condominium units, seven (7) commercial buildings including 67,200 sq ft of retail space and 100,800 sq ft of office space. The master plan also included a 12,000 sq ft stand-alone restaurant and 10,000 sq ft banquet hall.

Amended in 2016 and 2022, Carsen's Ferry PD (Rivertown Landing PDD) has changed to include the following:

- Commercial Tract 'C' rezoned to R2 in 2016
- Multifamily Tract- renamed Residential Tract and amended for single-family homes in 2016
- Commercial Tract 'B'- amended to allow all uses in HC

Currently, Carsen's Ferry PD (Rivertown Landing PDD) is a development consisting of two commercial lots and Carsen's Ferry residential subdivision. Carsen's Ferry is a high-density subdivision with houses spaced closely together in a traditional neighborhood layout. Streets are tree-lined and include sidewalks to create a pedestrian-friendly atmosphere.

It is proposed that the existing PD be revised to allow for a combination of residential, professional, and limited commercial (Mixed Use development) and rename Commercial Lot 'A' to Mixed Use Tract within this development.

The lot size is 4.24 acres.

#### Existing Commercial Lot 'A' PD requirements are as follows:

• Setbacks are as follows:

Front Yard: 30' Side Yard:10' Rear Yard: 0'

- Maximum building height shall be 50'. This dimension is measured from the ground elevation to the soffit of the building.

The maximum amount of commercial space within this tract is 15,000 square feet. An increase of in commercial square footage within this tract will require a major amendment.

#### 1. Mixed Use Tract:

The maximum allowable number of residential dwelling units within the 4.24 +/- acre of the Carsen's Ferry PD is six (7) units. The maximum allowable number of professional/commercial units within this tract is twelve (12) totaling no more than 18,000 square feet. An increase in residential/professional/commercial units will require a major amendment.

#### 2. Commercial Tract 'B':

The maximum amount of commercial space within this tract is 12,500 square feet. An increase of in commercial square footage within this tract will require a major amendment.

#### 3. Residential Tract:

#### 1. Commercial Tract 'A'

a. The tract is intended to be occupied by a restaurant. The required parking for this tract is one (1) space per three (3) seats, as defined in section 10.1070 of the City of Conway Zoning Ordinance.

#### 2. **Mixed Use Tract**

Mixed Use Tract is intended to not create excessive demands for additional vehicular parking. Cyclist and golf cart parking will be provided. Per Article 8, Parking Requirements for Specific Uses, one (1) space will be provided per Residence within a structure containing a non-residential use. Each unit will be provided at least two (2) spaces for non-residential uses. Units will utilize joint-use parking to accommodate peak hours of attendance/use.

- 2. Commercial Tract 'B"

  <u>Parking shall be provided as required by City of Conway</u>

  Unified Development Ordinance for proposed uses.
- 3. Residential Tract
  Two spaces per unit, one may be located within a garage

#### 4.2520 Common Open Space Requirements

A minimum of fifteen percent (15%) of the total area of this PDD must be devoted to active and passive open space, therefore, not less than 4.58 +/-acres of land must be retained in open space. Twenty-five percent (25%) of this open space will be made up of water surfaces. An amenity center with pool will also be installed as part of this PDD for use by owners and guests within the residential tract. Use may also be extended to owners within adjacent subdivisions. Below is a summary of the open space provided within this Planned District.

#### 4.2525 Utilities, Services, and Easements

All structures within the Rivertown Landing Planned Development District shall be connected to the City of Conway water and wastewater system. All utilities shall be located underground and shall be within the right-of-way of the road. Storm water shall be collected and stored onsite. Appropriate water, sewer and storm drainage easements shall be assigned to accommodate for these systems. All stormwater pipes and structures shall be maintained by the property owners association.

#### 4.2530 Access and Circulation

Primary access to Rivertown Landing shall be provided from U.S. Highway 501 and a secondary access shall be provided through the Tiger Grand Subdivision to accommodate vehicular traffic. Pedestrian traffic is encouraged and will be handled by a series of sidewalks located throughout the community. Roadways have been designed to accommodate emergency and safety vehicles.

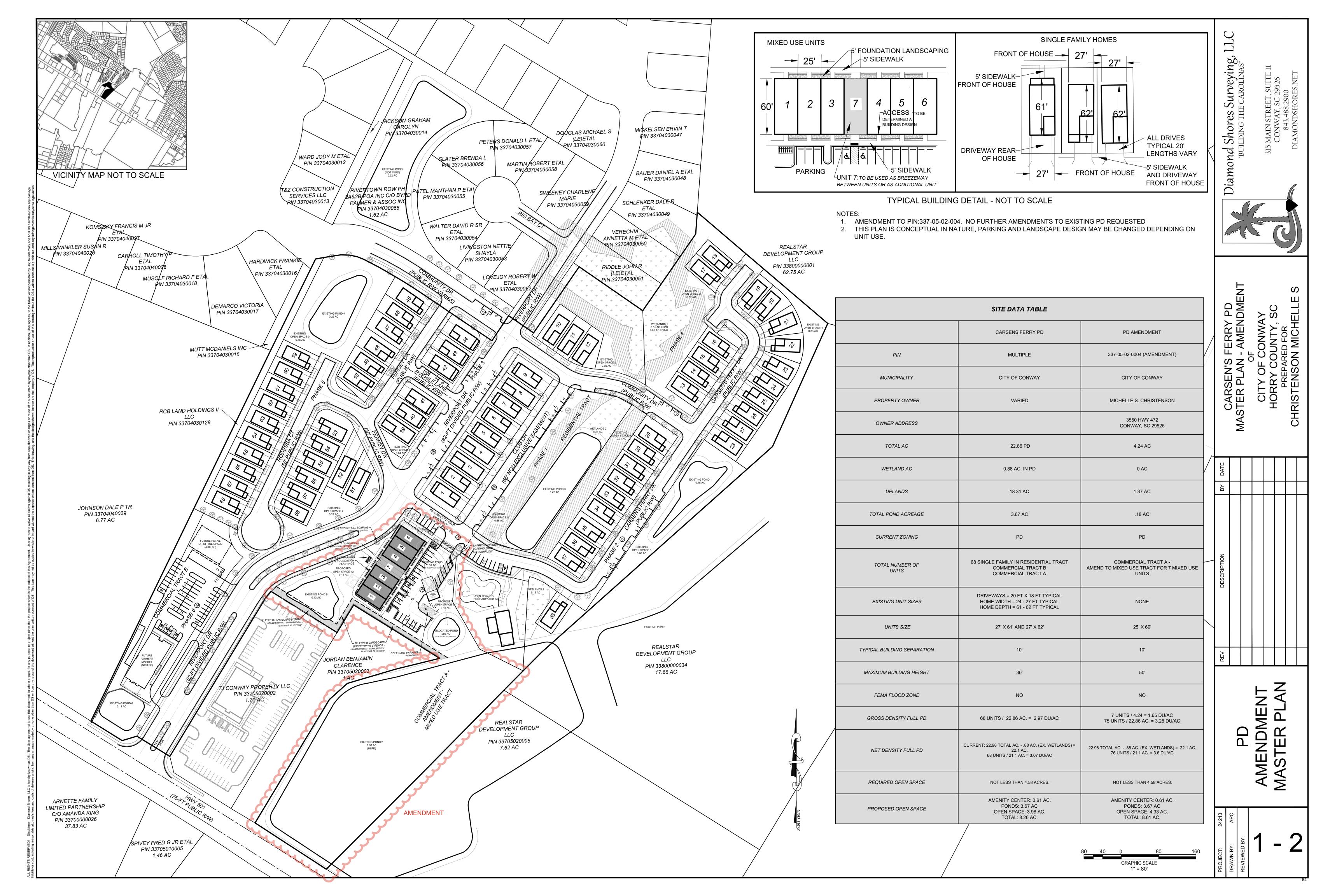

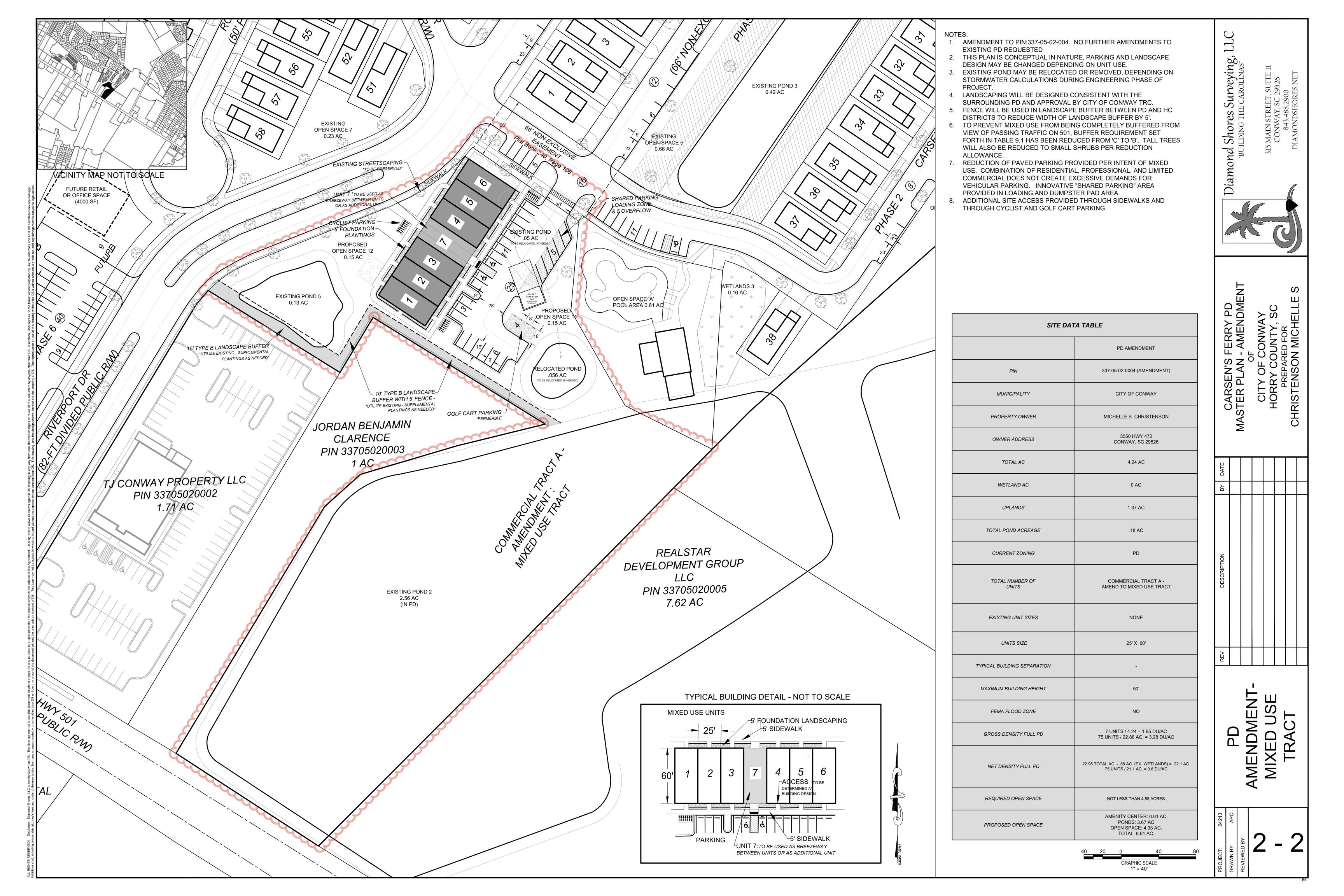
#### 4.2555 **Amendment Procedures**

The owner/applicant of an approved planned development may apply for an amendment of the plan of development in concept in minor detail.

A. In case of a change of concept, the applicant shall have the approval of the Planning Commission and the City Council and

- shall follow the same procedures as outlined in Section 4.2435.D. Changes of density, land use, land area, open space, type of community facilities, type of housing, type of commercial and industrial establishments, and the overall design layout shall be considered to be changes of concept.
- B. In case of a change of minor details, the City Planner may approve these changes upon being presented with a written request along with the necessary graphic and statistical information. Changes of location and design of structures, streets, parking, community facilities, landscaping, and utilities shall be considered to be changes of minor detail.

#### **ISSUE**:

Discussion of a request to rezone approximately 8.5+/- acres of property located on Technology Blvd (PIN's 383-10-03-0020 and -0026) from the Planned Development (PD) and Highway Commercial (HC) districts to the High-Density Residential (R-3) district, and a request to rezone 0.02+/- acres of property located on Technology Blvd (PIN 383-10-03-0027) from the Planned Development (PD) district to the High-Density Residential (R-3) district.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The applicant submitted a rezoning application for the subject property in March 2025. The properties are already in the city limits, zoned Planned Development (PD) district and Highway Commercial (HC). Two of the parcels include the University Suites Planned Development, with the small .02-acre parcel containing the pump station for University Suites. The other property, across Technology Blvd, is zoned Highway Commercial and is located directly behind the Food Lion shopping center. The applicant proposes to construct 24 multifamily units on the 1.75-acre parcel.

#### **Proposed Zoning of Property:**

The applicant is seeking to rezone the properties to High-Density Residential (R-3). Per Section 3.2.5 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO), the intent of the R-3 district is to provide areas for high-density attached, detached, semi-attached, and multifamily residential development in the City of Conway and to prohibit uses that would substantially interfere with the development or continuation of residential structures in the district.

#### **Surrounding uses/Zoning Districts:**

These parcels are located behind the Food Lion shopping center, which is zoned HC. It abuts an established single-family residential neighborhood (Coastal Heights), mostly zoned Horry County Residential, no mobile homes allowed (SF10); however, several lots within this development have been annexed into the city over the last few years and are zoned Low/Medium-Density Residential (R-1). The subject properties also abut property zoned Institutional (IN) that is owned by Horry-Georgetown Technical College (HGTC).

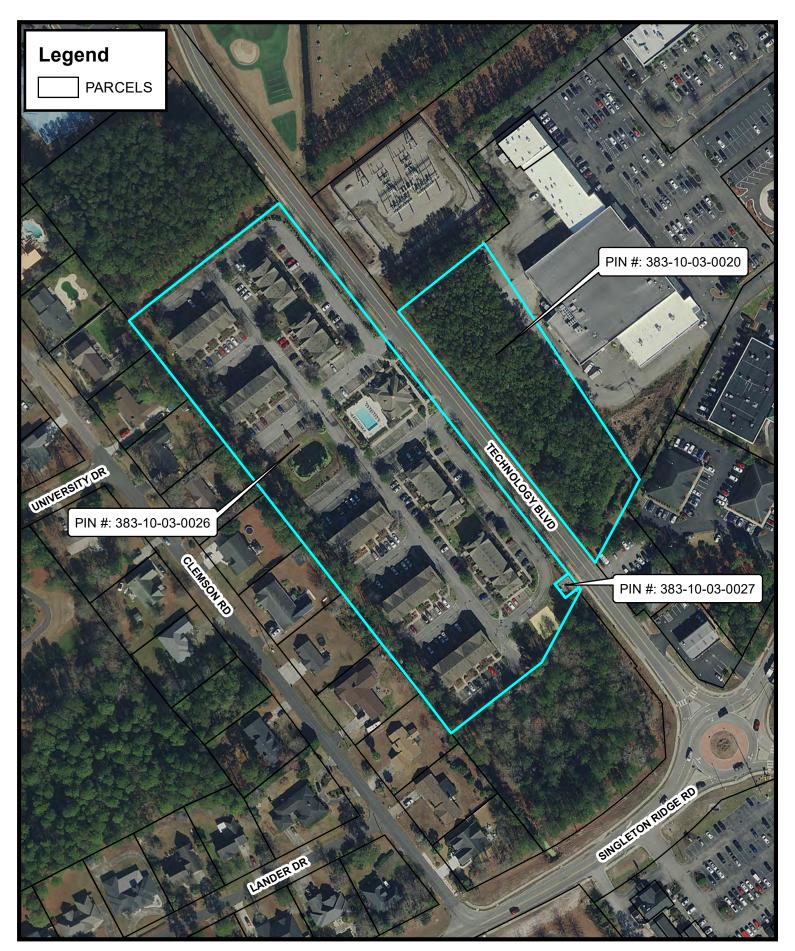
The properties are within walking distance to a shopping center, several food establishments, medical offices, a hospital, and both HGTC and Coastal Carolina University (CCU). There are already sidewalks along Technology Blvd, and there are several outlets for vehicular access to Hwy 501.

#### CITY OF CONWAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:

The future land use map of the *Comprehensive Plan* identifies the property as Highway Commercial (HC). Per Section 3.2.10 of the UDO, the intent of the HC district is to provide compatible locations to serve the automobile oriented commercial activities in harmony with major highway developments, reduce traffic congestions and to enhance the aesthetic atmosphere of the City.

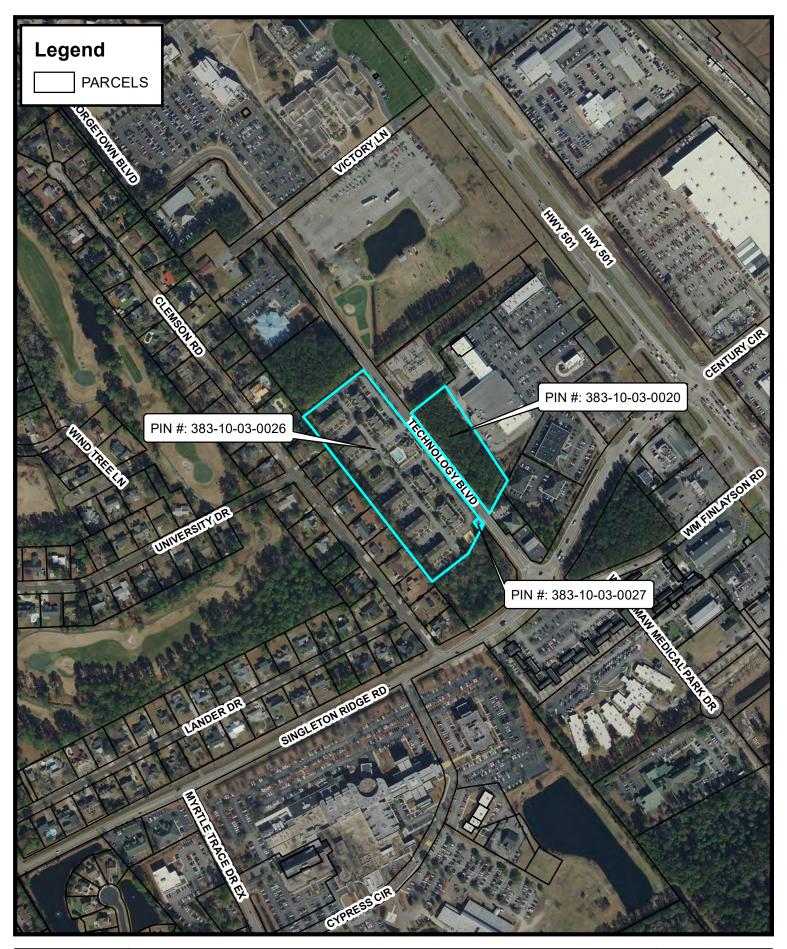
#### **PLANNING COMMISSION:**

#### **ISSUE**:

**First Reading of Ordinance** #**ZA2025-04-07** (**A**), to annex approximately 1.42+/- acres of property located on Bohemia Court and Century Circle in the Atlantic Center Industrial Park (PIN 383-11-02-0003), and request to rezone from the Horry County Planned Unit Development (PUD) district to the City of Conway Light Industrial (LI) district.

#### **BACKGROUND**:

The applicant submitted the annexation and rezoning application for the subject property on February 6, 2025. The property is currently in the county's jurisdiction, zoned Planned Unit Development (PUD), part of the Atlantic Center Industrial Park. The property is currently vacant.

The applicant is requesting to assign Light Industrial (LI) zoning to the property upon annexation.

Per Section 3.2.13 of the UDO, the intent of the LI district is to provide areas for light industrial uses, such as manufacturing, processing, repairing of goods, wholesaling, storage, packaging, distribution and retailing while ensuring adjacent and nearby properties are not adversely impacted.

#### **Surrounding uses/Zoning Districts:**

#### **ISSUE:**

**First Reading of Ordinance** #**ZA2025-04-07** (**B**), to annex approximately 0.17 acres located at 1073 Waccamaw Drive (PIN 368-13-03-0004) and rezone from Horry County Residential, including mobile homes (MSF10), to City of Conway Low/Medium Residential (R-1).

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The annexation application was submitted by the property owner, as a requirement for a name change to the city utility services account. According to Horry County Land Records, the property was acquired by the applicant on February 20, 2025. Currently, there is a residential structure on the property.

Across the Waccamaw River is a large property – consisting of approx. 490 acres – owned by S.C. Public Service Authority, and directly adjoining this parcel to the rear is a 152-acre tract of property owned by the City of Conway, since May 2019.

Per Section 3.2.3 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO), the intent of the R-1 District is to provide for the preservation and expansion of areas for low to medium density, detached single-family residential development in the City of Conway. The district shall present a relatively spacious character, promote quiet, livable neighborhoods, and prohibit uses that are incompatible with the residential nature of the surrounding area.

Most of the lots along Waccamaw Drive are considered contiguous to city property; however, all previous annexation petitions that have been submitted for properties along Waccamaw Drive were denied, including this property, which last requested annexation in January of 2023.

This entire area is within the AE flood zone.

#### CITY OF CONWAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:

The Future Land Use Map of the Comprehensive Plan identifies this parcel as Conservation Preservation (CP). #### **ISSUE**:

**First Reading of Ordinance** #**ZA2025-04-07** (**D**) to rezone approximately 7.8+/- acres of property located on (North) Main Street and Chicora Blvd (PIN 338-03-02-0006) from the Highway Commercial (HC) district to the High-Density Residential (R-3) district.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The applicant submitted a rezoning application for the subject property in January 2025. The property is already in the city limits, zoned Highway Commercial (HC). The property is currently vacant. The applicant is seeking to rezone the property to High-Density Residential (R-3) in order to develop the property as multifamily; more specifically, a workforce housing community.

Per Section 3.2.5 of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO), the intent of the R-3 district is to provide areas for high-density attached, detached, semi-attached, and multifamily residential development in the City of Conway and to prohibit uses that would substantially interfere with the development or continuation of residential structures in the district.

#### **Gateway Corridor Overlay (GCO) District:**

The subject property is also within the Gateway Corridor Overlay (GCO). Per Section 3.4.2 of the UDO, the intent of the overlay district is to create a commercial corridor that is well planned and attractive through the implementation of consistent design standards. The provisions of this section will ensure that the design quality of new development in the city's identified gateway corridors are held to high standards. This section (GCO) shall not apply to detached single-family residential dwellings being used for residential purposes.

Per Section 6.5.2, A. – Purpose, of the UDO, the GCO is established to provide standards relative to accessibility, appearance, and safety in the development of commercial, industrial, multifamily residential, and office projects that utilize highway corridors are their primary means of access.

Per Section 6.5.2, B. – Applicability, the GCO district shall extend 500 feet from the right-of-way line on properties along these highways (90, 378, 501, 501 Bus., 701 (South and North), and 905).

#### **Surrounding uses/Zoning Districts:**

The subject property abuts the Chicora development, a single-family neighborhood, zoned R-1 (low/medium-density residential). Other properties beside and across from the subject property are zoned Highway Commercial (HC). There is no other property zoned R-3 (high-density residential) in the nearby surrounding area. The property on the opposite side of Chicora Blvd (currently vacant) had previously been proposed and approved for a grocery store (KJ's) to be developed.

#### CITY OF CONWAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:

The future land use map of the *Comprehensive Plan* identifies the property as Highway Commercial (HC). Per Section 3.2.10 of the UDO, the intent of the HC district is to provide compatible locations to serve the automobile oriented commercial activities in harmony with major highway developments,

reduce traffic congestions and to enhance the aesthetic atmosphere of the City.

#### **PLANNING COMMISSION:**

Planning Commission held the required public hearing on the request at their March 6<sup>th</sup> meeting and recommended disapproval of the request to rezone the property to High-Density Residential (R-3), although it was not unanimous. Several residents of the Chicora neighborhood were present and gave public input, in opposition to the request. Their concerns included traffic along Chicora Blvd and Hwy 701, crime, stormwater drainage and flooding issues.

#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Workforce housing and affordable / attainable housing is needed in and around Conway. The costs of housing has increased significantly over the past several years; specifically post-Covid, with many people relocating to the area from other parts of the country, the shortage in housing supply, as well as inflation. Adequate housing is not always *attainable* for many individuals who work in and around our community, such as our teachers, nurses, police, firefighters, and others in similar professions, as these individuals make too much money to qualify for low-income housing and not enough money to purchase a home.

While housing affordability is an issue, it is a much broader issue than just the zoning of property. Lack of affordability / attainability of housing cannot be solved *just* by rezoning properties to districts that allow higher density. Zoning districts which would allow higher densities could add to the housing supply if properties are developed as zoning (density) allows, but what must be considered when reviewing a request to rezone property is whether the requesting zoning is appropriate for the subject property. Staff must first consult the Comprehensive Plan to see if the proposed rezoning is consistent with the plan and the future land use map. Other factors that can influence recommendations and decisions regarding rezoning requests include, *but are not limited to*:

- Current and proposed land use;
- How the requesting zoning would affect nearby properties (and public opposition);
- Whether existing infrastructure is adequate and if not, what infrastructure may be necessary;
- Environmental impacts (wetlands, flood zones, etc.);
- Economic impacts;
- Past decisions for similar requests;
- Recommendation of Planning Commission

The property is currently zoned Highway Commercial (HC), as is all other surrounding properties fronting on either side of Hwy 701 N. (N. Main St.). The Future Land Use Map also identifies the property as HC. There is no property in the immediate area that is already zoned R-3. There is property zoned R-2 (medium-density residential) on Cultra Rd / Oak Street and Boundary Street; none of which front a major corridor.

There are no flood zones on the subject property; however, the adjacent property is within a flood zone as well as properties across the road, and areas near this portion of Hwy 701 North have been known to

flood during major rain events. *However*, I do want to note that – if developed as proposed, it's likely there would be less impervious surface area resulting from the development than if it were to be developed commercially, resulting in less stormwater runoff.

There is strong opposition from the neighboring community to this request, with concerns related to traffic, crime, and flooding; as previously mentioned.

Council has previously denied rezoning requests for zoning other than what the future land use map shows for properties along major corridors in the city (Hwy 501 bypass), in an effort to preserve these commercial corridors.

Finally, Planning Commission recommended disapproval of the requesting zoning of R-3.

Based on these factors, including the recommendation of Planning Commission, staff recommends disapproval of the request.

- **WHEREAS,** City Council determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Conway and its citizens to approve the rezoning petition as presented. Therefore, be it

Rezone approximately 7.8+/- (total) acres located on (North) Main Street and Chicora Blvd (PIN 338-03-02-0006) from the Highway Commercial (HC) district to the High-Density Residential (R-3); and be it further

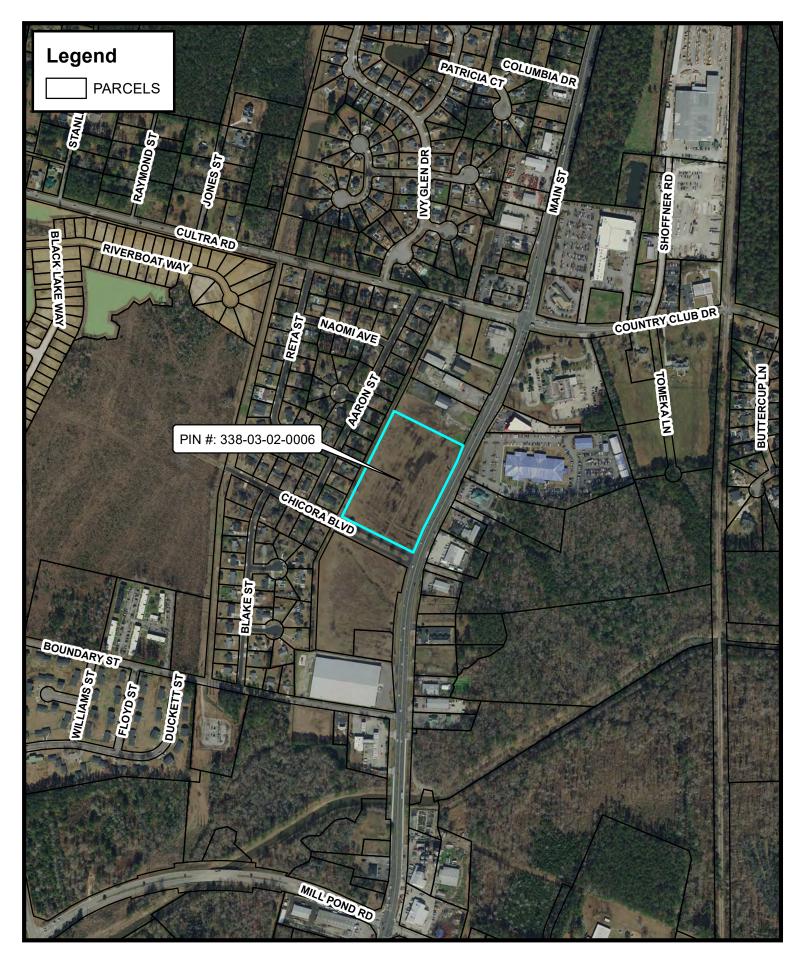

Re: Letter of Support - Request to Rezone ~7.8 acres, Chicora Blvd & Main Street

Mayor Blain and Members of Conway City Council,

In recent weeks, we've spoken with community members, Planning Commission members, and City staff about rezoning parcel 338-03-02-0006 from Highway Commercial (HC) to High-Density Residential (R-3). We submit this Letter of Support as a follow-up to those conversations and meetings to address questions raised and request that it be included in the official rezoning record.

After these conversations, it is clear that rezoning to R-3 to support this development will provide greater community benefits to the City of Conway, its residents, businesses, and the neighbors. Additionally, we have applied to SC Housing for tax-credit funding to develop a family affordable workforce housing community and expect our application to be highly competitive.

Please consider the following in support of the rezoning request:

#### There is a critical need for affordable workforce housing in Conway.

- This rezoning will allow the site to be developed as a privately owned, critically needed affordable workforce housing community.
- There are long waiting lists for existing affordable housing in the area.
- Average rents in Conway are over \$1,850, up 66% county-wide in the last decade.
- Businesses need a strong pool of local employees as there are over 4,000 jobs in a
   2-mile radius from the site paying wages our future residents will be making.

#### • The opportunity is now – it is rare and may not come again soon.

- There is no better site suited for this type of development in Conway than this one, based on SC Housing's stringent development criteria.
- The last workforce housing community to receive tax credits in Conway was almost two decades ago.
- If rezoning does not occur, Conway may not have another opportunity for a competitive development like this for a long time.

#### • Rezoning addresses existing stormwater concerns.

The down zoning of this site to R-3, coupled with our thoughtful site plan with large greenspaces and stormwater detention pond will be significantly better for the environment and flooding concerns. HC development would likely have significantly more paving and impermeable surfaces.

#### • R3 results in reduced traffic impact compared to HC uses.

- Reducing the density from HC to R-3 will reduce the potential traffic impact to the neighborhood and surrounding areas.
- Construction of a maximum of 80 housing units (max limit imposed by SC Housing) will likely result in fewer daily trips than currently allowed HC development could, based on ITE's Trip Generation Manual, 11<sup>th</sup> edition.

#### • R3 provides opportunity for enhanced transitioning from Residential to Commercial.

- Multi-family developments are commonly used to create a transitional buffer between residential and commercial zoning areas.
- Rezoning to R-3 will provide a reasonable and attractive transition between the residential and commercial uses, while providing more greenspace.
- Chicora Springs Trace is designed to smoothly transition between single-family homes and the highway commercial properties, with a 2-story building on Chicora Blvd to complement the neighborhood and 3-story buildings on Main St to complement its commercial character.

#### • Improved landscaping and protected buffer to nearby residential areas.

- The proposed site plan reflects our commitment to providing a maximum amount of greenspace and landscaping buffer to the Chicora neighborhood.
- HC developments would likely have large buildings located at the north of the site near the existing neighborhood with supply trucks just outside of neighbor's yards.

Proper zoning is required for tax credit financing through SC Housing. Our proposed development is the only tax credit application in Conway this year. Denial would prevent us from securing funding, delaying much-needed workforce housing in Conway indefinitely.

We strongly support the rezoning request and urge its approval. This development is the best use of the parcel, balancing residential and commercial areas while addressing community concerns and providing much needed affordable workforce housing.

#### **Introduction**

Chicora Springs Trace is a proposed 80-unit workforce housing community at the corner of Chicora Boulevard and North Main Street developed by Greenville, NC-based Taft-Mills Group, LLC. The proposed site is well located to provide much needed housing affordable to residents serving vital roles in the community. High quality housing at affordable prices is becoming incredibly difficult to find in Conway, and other desirable places to live. Chicora Springs Trace is specifically designed to help meet that need in the community.

The site is in a great location for a workforce community. It is near many employers, parks, retail options, service providers, schools, a library, and downtown shops. The proposed development, once completed, will represent an over \$22 million-dollar investment in the community.

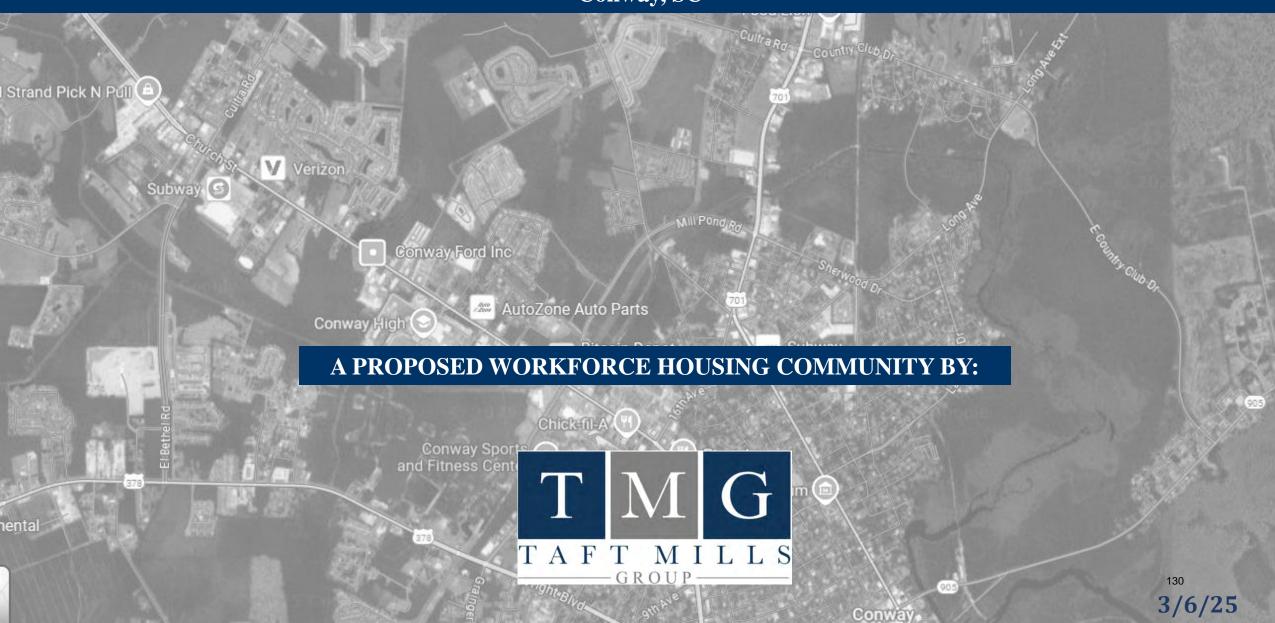

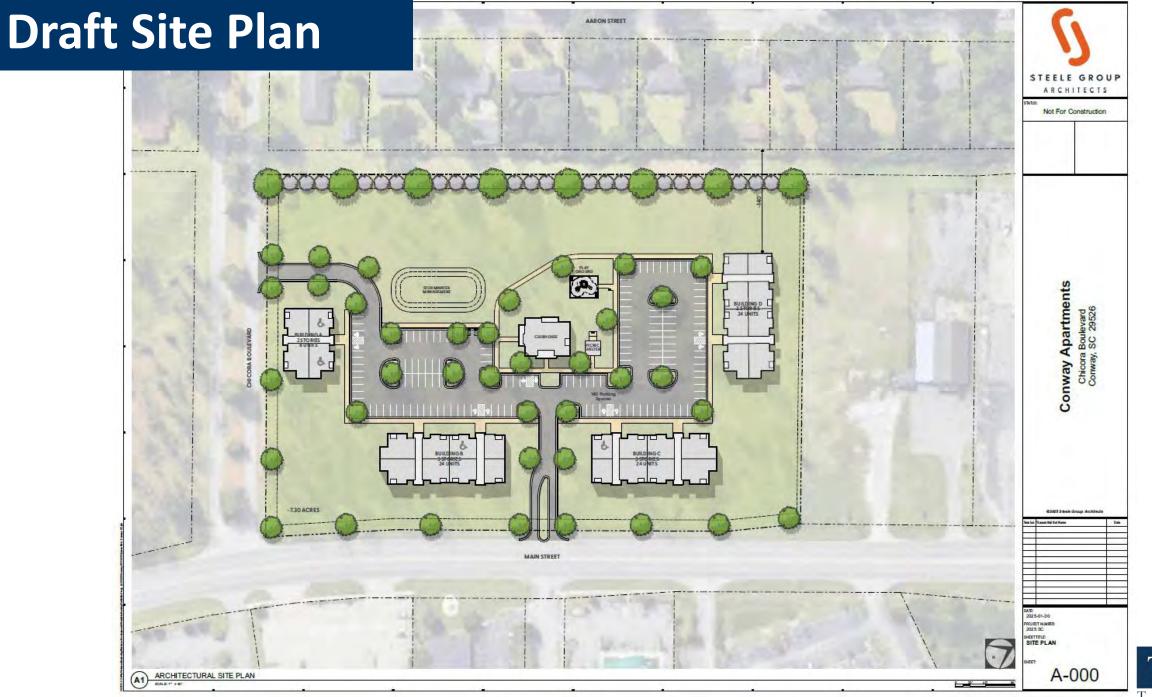

#### **ISSUE:**

**First Reading of Ordinance** #**ZA2025-04-07** (**E**), to annex approximately 2.72 acres located at 966 West Cox Ferry Road (PIN 382-07-01-0011), and rezone from Horry County Commercial Forest Agriculture (CFA) to City of Conway Low/Medium Density Residential (R-1).

#### **BACKGROUND:**

On March 4, 2025, the annexation petition was submitted in accordance with the requirements for a new connection to city utilities (new account). Horry County Code Enforcement notified City staff that the property owner had submitted an application for a proposed accessory dwelling unit (ADU) on the property. More recently, a 2,000 sq. ft. detached metal garage was erected on the property, which was permitted by Horry County Code Enforcement, with a final inspection on March 4, 2025. According to Horry County Land Records, the property was transferred into the applicant's name on July 12, 2024. The adjacent property, 970 West Cox Ferry Road, was annexed in 2022, making this property contiguous. A restrictive covenant was recorded on March 4, 2025 for this property.

#### **CITY OF CONWAY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN:**

The Future Land Use Map of the Comprehensive Plan identifies this parcel as Conservation Preservation (CP). Per Section 3.2.17 of the UDO, The intent of the CP District is to provide needed open space for general outdoor and indoor recreational uses, and to protect environmentally sensitive areas and flood prone areas from the encroachment of any residential, commercial, industrial, or other uses capable of adversely affecting the relatively undeveloped character of the district.

#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends against annexation of this property for the following reasons:

The property is 2.72 acres and is large enough to accommodate another residential structure; however, the property owner's address is not 966 W. Cox Ferry Rd, and the requirements for Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU's) are not the same as the city's requirements. Some of these requirements include:

- ADU's be located in the rear yard of the principal dwelling, unless they are a part of an attached or detached garage, which may be located in the side yard.
- ADU's cannot be located forward the principal dwelling.
- ADU's cannot exceed 50% of the gross floor area of the principal dwelling.

According to the site plan that was provided, the proposed ADU does not appear to be in compliance with the City's requirements for ADU's.

Weldon Lane is a dead end, and other properties; some of which have not yet been developed on, will have to request annexation when a permit application is submitted at the county if contiguous and City utilities are requested. Weldon Lane is currently a county road, and it does not appear to be improved all the way to the dead end, which could force property owners to improve (pave) Weldon Lane prior to any permits being issued. Abrams Court is in the same condition. If properties on Weldon Lane begin being annexed, the right of way in front of each property will also be annexed and would eventually be turned over to the city for maintenance even though they are substandard, or not even paved. This could cause an undue hardship on property owners on Weldon Lane and Abrams Court who may seek to construct residences on the vacant lots in the future, as the county does not require the same road improvements. Additionally, although this property is addressed on W. Cox Ferry Rd, the only frontage the property has is on Weldon Lane, and properties on either side of it are addressed on Weldon Lane. This could be an issue with addressing.

A metal building was recently constructed on the property that is approx. 2,000 sq. ft., and City ordinance prohibits accessory structures 400 sq. ft. and greater from being constructed of metal. They are also required to architecturally compliment the primary structure.

One parcel (abutting the subject property) that fronts Weldon Lane is 17.7 acres, and while there is currently a residence on it, there is potential for the property to be developed as a major subdivision at some point in the future. Approximately half of that parcel is within a flood zone, so should a major subdivision be proposed for that property at any point in the future, there may be an opportunity for the City to zone these areas (or portions of) as Conservation Preservation (CP) upon annexation to protect the environmentally sensitive areas and improve Weldon Lane to a standard that is more in line with City standards.

If the owner of the subject property were to seek further subdivision of the property, or if the property is sold to another individual, they would again have to request annexation at that time. Additionally, now that restrictive covenants are on file and recorded, the City could also require annexation at any time. For now, staff believes annexation of the subject property would be premature.
