**ORDINANCE #2022-09-29**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT A LOCALIZED STATE OF EMERGENCY EXISTS WITHIN THE CITY OF CONWAY AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO BE TAKEN IN CONNECTION THEREWITH**

**WHEREAS,** Conway City Council is empowered by Section 5-7-250 of the South Carolina Code of Laws and Section 1-3-27 of the City of Conway Code of Ordinances to enact emergency ordinances to meet public emergencies affecting life, health, safety or the property of the people; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 5-7-250, such emergency ordinance shall be enacted by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of Council present, is effective immediately upon its enactment without regard to any reading, public hearing, publication requirements, or public notice requirements, and shall expire automatically as of the sixty-first day following the date of enactment (unless sooner terminated as conditions warrant); and

**WHEREAS,** City Council finds it necessary to enact an emergency ordinance as a result of its determination that a localized emergency exists within the City of Conway and directs that certain measures are to be taken to address that emergency:

**WHEREAS,** City Council on September 29, 2022, enacted Ordinance #2022-09-29 An Emergency Ordinance Declaring That a Localized State of Emergency Exists within the City of Conway and Authorizing the Appropriate Action to be Taken in Connection Therewith; Therefore be it

**ORDAINED,** by the power and authority granted to the Conway City Council, that the following hereby is enacted:

- 1. DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY:** In accordance with Section 5-7-250 of the South Carolina Code and Section 1-3-27 of the City of Conway Code, City Council hereby declares that a localized civil emergency exists throughout the City of Conway, more particularly described in the attached Declaration of a State of Emergency for the City of Conway, and hereby directs that appropriate action be taken as set forth in such Declaration.
- 2. TERMINATION/EXPIRATION.** This Ordinance will remain in effect for sixty (60) days unless sooner terminated by City Council.
- 3. SEVERABILITY.** If any Section, Subsection, or part of this Ordinance shall be deemed or found to conflict with a provision of South Carolina law, or other pre-emptive legal principle, then that Section, Sub-section or part of this Ordinance shall be deemed ineffective, but the remaining parts of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon ratification.
