Board Meeting – January 25, 2022
Conway Sports and Fitness Center – Rivertown Room

Members Present: Ben Burroughs, Kathy Mangum, Steve Mangum, Nevada Mileur – Executive Director, Jill Miller, Chris Oglebay, Timmy Williams – City of Conway Grounds & Maintenance Director

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm by Chairman Burroughs.

Purpose of Meeting: To meet Nevada Mileur – newly hired Litter Control Coordinator for City of Conway and Executive Director for KCB

Approval of Minutes of October 26, 2021: The minutes were approved as read.

New Business/Updates/Action Items:

- Williams introduced Nevada Mileur to the board and reported that Mileur has been given all of the information related to the formation of KCB to its KAB affiliate status and is now “up to speed” with the board’s business.
- Williams reported that in December of 2021 the City of Conway Grounds & Maintenance Department partnered with Horry County and conducted a successful litter pickup around the Hwy. 501 overpass bridge over Hwy. 701. Mileur has been put in contact with proper Horry County representatives to coordinate more litter pickups.
- The city’s Grounds and Maintenance Department conducted a litter pickup in the area of east Conway and Hwy. 905. Plans are for the city to conduct five to ten litter pickups per month.
- According to Williams, three deer cameras have been installed at Inlet Drive to capture litter violators.
- The Grounds & Maintenance Department has identified four locations within the city where full trash bags have been thrown into ditches. The department is willing to go through the trash bags to get identification of the owners if the city agrees to take action against them. Williams will talk with city administrators to ask if they will agree to hold the violators accountable by issuing a fine or requiring them to remove and properly dispose the litter.
- Burroughs welcomed Mileur to the board then relayed a list of priorities that KCB needs to move forward.
 - KCB Face Book Page
 - KCB information to be included on the city’s website
 - DOT coordinating with the city for litter pickup prior to cutting grass on shoulders and medians
 - Partnering with Conway neighborhood associations for beautification projects and litter control
- Mileur introduced herself and gave a presentation of the research she’s done thus far including website links of projects that KCB might consider to adopt. She will forward her presentation to the members for further review.
- Burroughs asked Mileur if she would consider speaking to Conway civic clubs about KCB to gain more exposure in the community. She agreed to the idea.
- Williams mentioned that the wall-mount cigarette butt dispenser that was given to The Crafty Rooster restaurant has not yet been installed. Mileur will reach out to encourage them to use it. She

mentioned that there are locations that have receptacles that use college rival separators as a way to entice fan usage.

- Williams reported that the city's Litter Hot Line phone number will go directly to Mileur and that the city is obligated to respond within 24 hours.
- Burroughs brought up the fact that our bylaws state we are to have seven voting board members and currently have six. Oglebay mentioned that she may know someone that would be interested and will report back to the board.
- Officers for 2022 were re-elected by the board as follows:
 - Chair – Ben Burroughs
 - Vice Chair – Steve Mangum
 - Secretary – Kathy Mangum
- Because the board does not meet during the month of December due to the holidays, the next vote to reelect officers for 2023 will be held during the November 2022 board meeting.
- Mileur will set up a calendar to post upcoming KCB events and KAB report due dates.


