Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Vice-Chair S. Mangum.

Approval of Agenda: The meeting agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes of June 28, 2022: DeAngelis motioned to accept the minutes as written, seconded by Oglebay and unanimously approved by the board.

Public Input: There was no public input.

New Business/Updates/Action Items:

- Mileur presented the Litter Control Coordinator's Report.
 - Litter Enforcement/Cleanups
 - July Community Cleanups
 - Seacoast Church at the Waccamaw River Park
 - St. James Catholic Church on Cox Ferry Road
 - Illegal Dumping
 - The city's Grounds & Maintenance crew cleared three areas of illegal dumping:
 - East Country Club, Inlet Lane, 5th & Main St.
 - Monthly Cleanup
 - Conway Sports & Fitness Center on July 28, 2022
 - Downtown Conway on August 25, 2022
 - Grounds and Maintenance Dept. Security Cameras
 - Williams reported that the four cameras installed around the city have resulted in law enforcement making two arrests and one citation involving illegal dumping and breaking and entering.
 - Education
 - Mileur was the guest speaker at the Conway Kiwanis Club meeting on July 26th.
 - SCDHEC offers environmental education workshops on "Action for a Cleaner Tomorrow" which is an activity-based curriculum that provides an introduction to solid waste, recycling and composting to K-12 grade students. Mileur signed up to attend the next virtual workshop to be held on July 28th.
 - Mileur will again reach out to school principals and Green Teams to offer classroom visits to speak about litter and recycling.

- Recycling E-Waste
 - Mileur to contact Horry County Solid Waste Authority to inquire how they recycle e-waste.
 - The closest non-profit refurbishers of e-waste are in NC and GA. Mileur will reach out to them and ask if they would be interested in the e-waste that the city collects.
 - Miller contacted AZ StRUT (Arizona Students Recycling Used Technology) for additional information about their program. She reported to Mileur that they would be willing to walk us through the process of implementing the program.
- Williams reported that twice a year all city department heads are required to present to City Council their departmental updates. He appointed Mileur to be the presenter at the meeting on August 15 to give an overview of the year-to-date accomplishments regarding litter control.
- Williams reported that the city has renamed the Grounds and Maintenance Department to the Hospitality and Beautification Department.

Next Meeting: The board will meet on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. in the Rivertown Room at the Conway Sports and Fitness Center.


