**RESOLUTION NAMING THE NEW BUILDING AT LAKE DARPO
THE DOUGLAS CLUBHOUSE AT LAKE DARPO**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Darlington County Council to recognize Councilman Dannie Douglas, Jr. for his tireless efforts and dedication to the county; and

WHEREAS, Dannie Douglas, Jr. was born in Darlington County and graduated from Mayo High School in 1958. After graduation, he relocated to New Jersey and served a short stint in the United States Air Force; and

WHEREAS, Dannie Douglas, Jr. returned to Darlington County during the 1960's and began his law enforcement career in 1972 as a Darlington County Sheriff Deputy under the leadership of Sheriff Jack O'Tuel. In 1981, he continued his law enforcement career with Society Hill Police Department where he was promoted and served as Police Chief for 18 years until his retirement in 2001; and

WHEREAS, Dannie Douglas, Jr. continued serving his community and the county upon being elected in 2003 to represent the citizens in Darlington County Council District 2 (Dovesville, Mechanicsville, Centerville, Society Hill areas) and is now serving his fifth term in office; and

WHEREAS, Dannie Douglas, Jr. also has continued farming and serving Mt. Zion Baptist Church family as Chairman of the Deacon Board for the past 15 years; and

WHEREAS, Dannie Douglas, Jr. has demonstrated loyalty, compassion, professionalism, and dedication to the citizens of Darlington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of Darlington County, the Darlington County Council, to honor Councilman Dannie Douglas, Jr. for his dedication and commitment to the citizens and government of Darlington County by naming the new building located at 190 Lake Darpo Road in Society Hill **The Douglas Clubhouse At Lake Darpo**.
