GENERAL LEASE CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. **BACKGROUND:** Darlington County, SC ("The County") owns approximately 103.7 acres of land adjacent to the Darlington County Landfill.
- 2. SCOPE: The County wishes to enter into a Lease with a farmer or grower. The Tenant may raise crops such as vegetables, grain, corn, soybeans, wheat, barley, rye or oats, or hay to list a few items. The tenant may either single crop or double crop the premise. All crops must be planted and harvest within the Lease Term. The Lessee agrees to use the land for the production of crops and to maintain said land in good condition. In the event that crops are not planted during any given growing season, the lessee will keep vegetation cut below an eighteen inch (18") level.
- 3. **PRICES:** The price quoted per acre of this premise shall remain firm for the period covered by the Lease. The price quoted is the amount of money per acre that the successful bidder shall pay the County for the term of the Lease.
- 4. **TERM OF LEASE:** The initial terms of the lease is for (5) years beginning January 6, 2018 and ending October 31, 2023.
- 5. <u>METHOD OF AWARD:</u> Award of this Lease will be made on the entire parcel. Award will be made to the highest responsive and responsible bidder. The reputation of the Bidder regarding adequacy of their past skillful performance of work of this type of magnitude required herein, shall be considered with making award.
- 6. **RENT PAYMENTS:** Rent payments shall be payable annually on or before the first day of each covered year, January 06. The County may terminate the Lease if rent payment is not received by October 31st of each Lease year.

Darlington County will not be responsible for any losses of the Lessee incurred after October 31 st of the year of termination.
