Curbside Recycling

Acceptable recyclables must be **loose** in a reusable container(s). Please label containers with a recycling decal.* Recycling containers (32-gallon size recommended) must have handles, preferably lids, and must not exceed 50 pounds in weight when full.

Do not put recyclables out in plastic bags.**

Do not put/mix plastic bags in recycling containers with acceptable recyclables.

There is only one exception for plastic bags; shredded paper in clear or translucent plastic bags.

Please refer to the Single-stream recycling flyer to see acceptable recyclables.

**Plastic bags (clean and dry) can be recycled at local retail stores in bins designated for plastic bags.
